Implicit Bias, A Journey Inward

The core of this training is to have an understanding of what implicit bias is, raise awareness of its effects and impacts in our communities including the workplace. The class will also introduce strategies to mitigate implicit Bias. The class content will begin with training goals and objectives, introductions, 5 key glossary terms, and useful concepts to help navigate the session. The next section will focus on examining what implicit bias is, unconscious bias behaviors, and how bias is manifested. The instructor will discuss the effects and impacts of bias. Finally, the participants will learn strategies to mitigate implicit bias, followed by a wrap-up with takeaway homework and what participants have learned.

Target Audience

This class meets the professional needs of social workers and is designed with all health and human services staff in mind. We encourage all members of DHHS staff and our Community Partners to attend.

- Understand what implicit bias is and how it impacts our decision-making process
- Gain an awareness of our own personal biases.
- Recognize barriers and limitations resulting from implicit biases.
- Apply approaches to mitigate implicit biases.
- Improve one's own channels of communications with others.
