



AUTOMOBILE BOULEVARD RESURFACING PROJECT

Silver Spring, MD

PURPOSE

This newsletter is to inform you of the upcoming road resurfacing of Automobile Boulevard. Please see the reverse side of this newsletter for the project map. This project will consist of milling, patching, and resurfacing the existing pavement. This pavement system preservation project employs long term strategies to improve roadway conditions.



IMPACTS

No parking signs may be posted in advance of patching on your street. You will have access to your driveway and street throughout the duration of the project. Please walk or drive carefully through the work zone and obey all posted signage. We thank you for your cooperation and patience as we work to improve the County infrastructure for residents and users.



SCHEDULE

This project is scheduled to start in May 2024 and will take four to six weeks to complete, weather and other operational requirements permitting. Work hours will be between 8PM and 6AM, Monday through Friday.

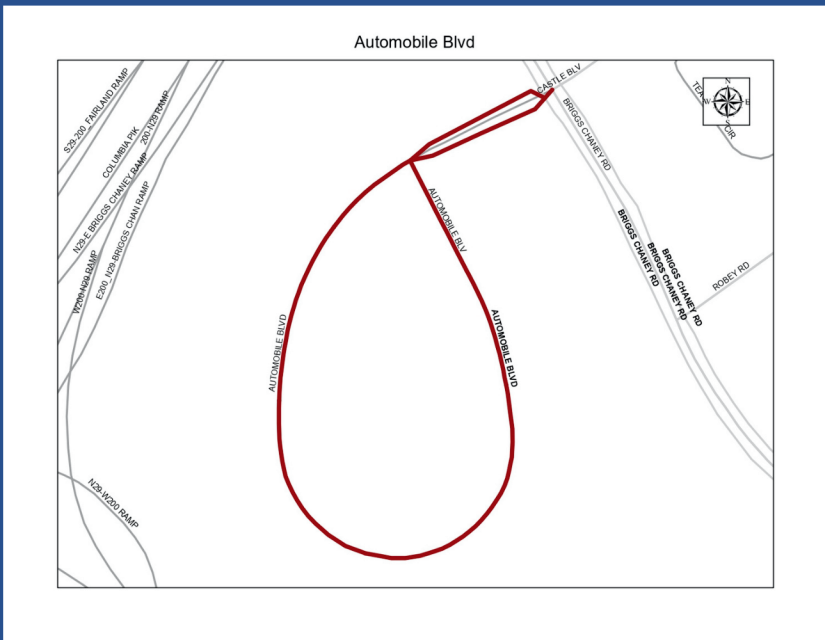
