This newsletter is to inform you of the upcoming permanent patching of the Potomac Manors neighborhood. Please see the reverse side of this newsletter for the project map. This pavement system preservation project employs long term strategies to improve roadway conditions.



SCHEDULE

This project is scheduled to start in March 2024 and will take 1-2 weeks complete, weather and other operational requirements permitting. Work hours will be between 7am and 5pm, Monday through Friday.

No parking signs may be posted in advance of patching on your street. You will have access to your driveway and street throughout the duration of the project. Please walk or drive carefully through the work zone and obey all posted signage. 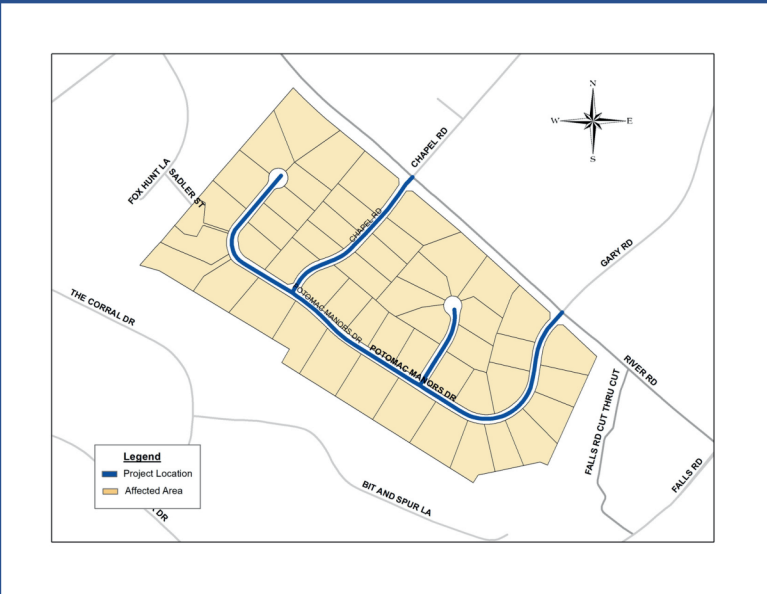
