New Installations

Additional streetlights will not be approved if existing lights conform to County standards.

If these standards are not met, additional lights will be considered under the following conditions:

- 1. If a residential area, written concurrence from at least two-thirds majority of the affected residents, i.e. residents with property abutting the area to be lit, is required. A petition (petition,doc) is available for your use. A petition is not required for business or industrial areas.
- 2. Streetlights are to be provided on every usable utility pole, but not spaced less than 80' apart.
- 3. If there are no existing street lights, installation shall be on a street basis, if possible.
- 4. Additional street lights may be provided on a street to street basis or on an individual basis.
- 5. No street lights will be installed on undeveloped road sections unless for safety considerations, e.g. walkways, accident problems, adverse geometric, etc.
- 6. Intersection lighting may be provided without concurrence of abutting property owners, but prefer, if possible.
- 7. Once a streetlight is installed, it should not be removed unless there are extenuating circumstances.
