

New Installations

Additional streetlights will not be approved if existing lights conform to County standards.

If these standards are not met, additional lights will be considered under the following conditions:

1. If a residential area, written concurrence from at least two-thirds majority of the affected residents, i.e. residents with property abutting the area to be lit, is required. A petition (petition.doc) is available for your use. A petition is not required for business or industrial areas.
2. Streetlights are to be provided on every usable utility pole, but not spaced less than 80' apart.
3. If there are no existing street lights, installation shall be on a street basis, if possible.
4. Additional street lights may be provided on a street to street basis or on an individual basis.
5. No street lights will be installed on undeveloped road sections unless for safety considerations, e.g. walkways, accident problems, adverse geometric, etc.
6. Intersection lighting may be provided without concurrence of abutting property owners, but prefer, if possible.
7. Once a streetlight is installed, it should not be removed unless there are extenuating circumstances.
