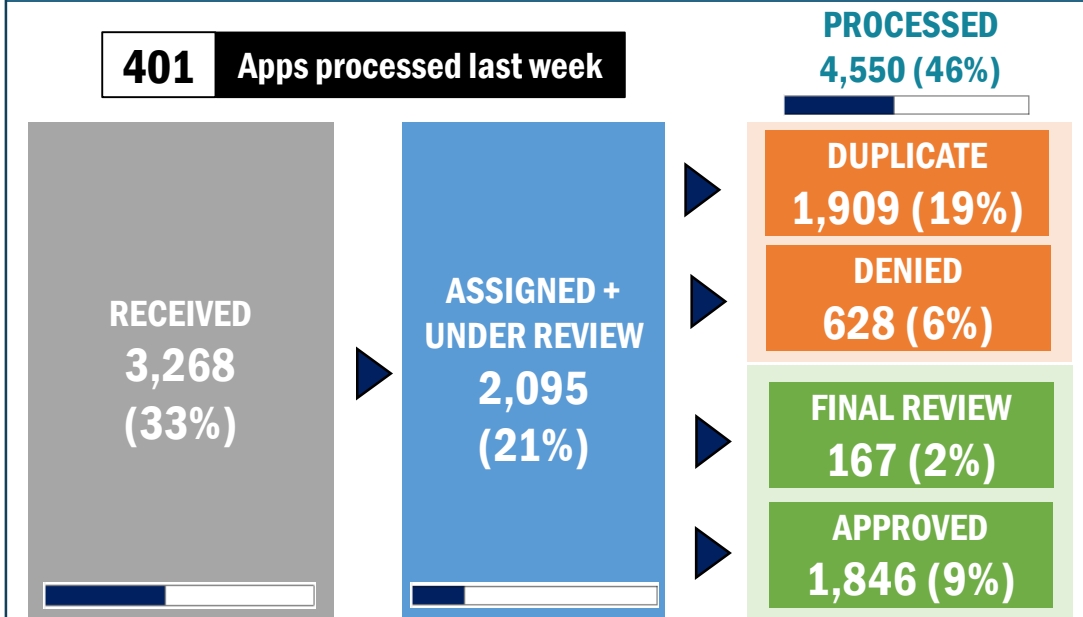

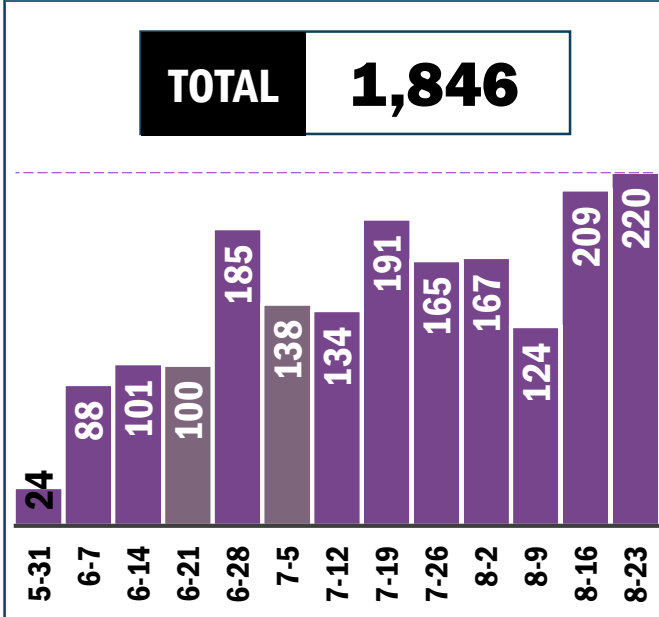

## 65% SPENDING TARGET TRACKER

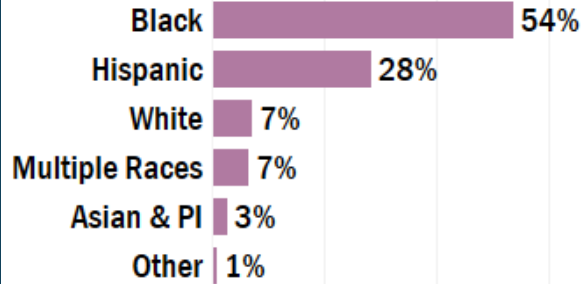

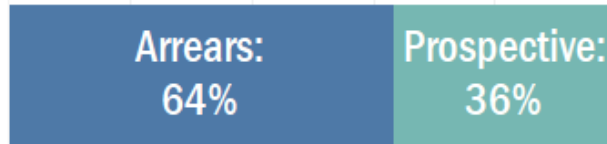

## RECIPIENTS' RACE/ETHNICITY

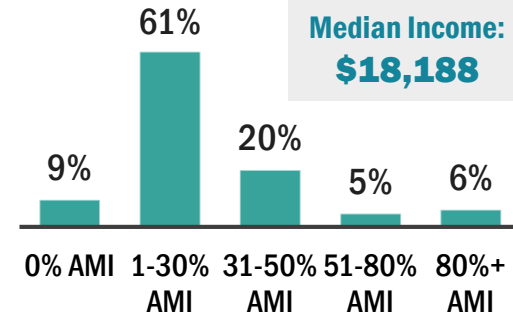

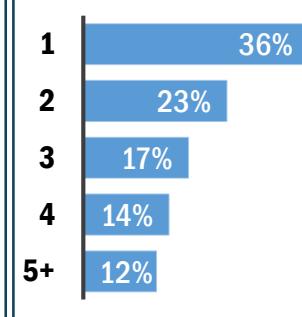

## % OF AREA MEDIAN INCOME



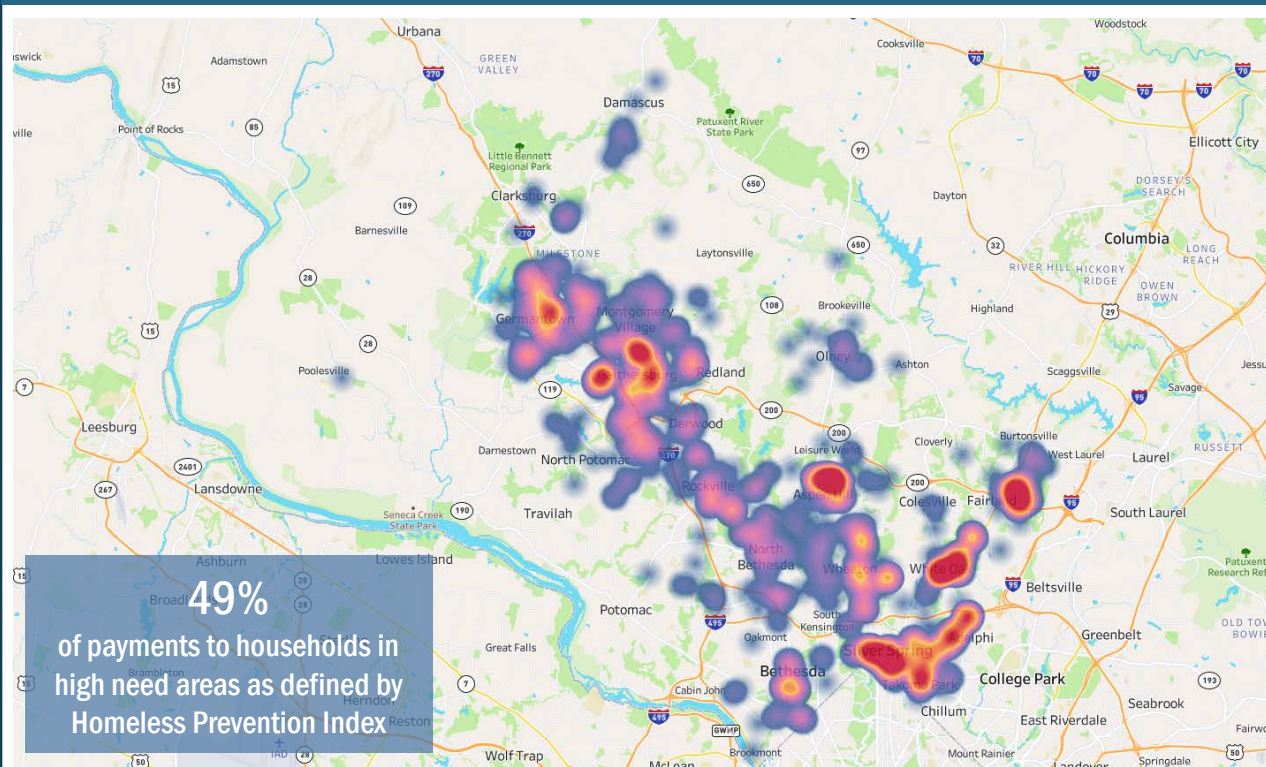

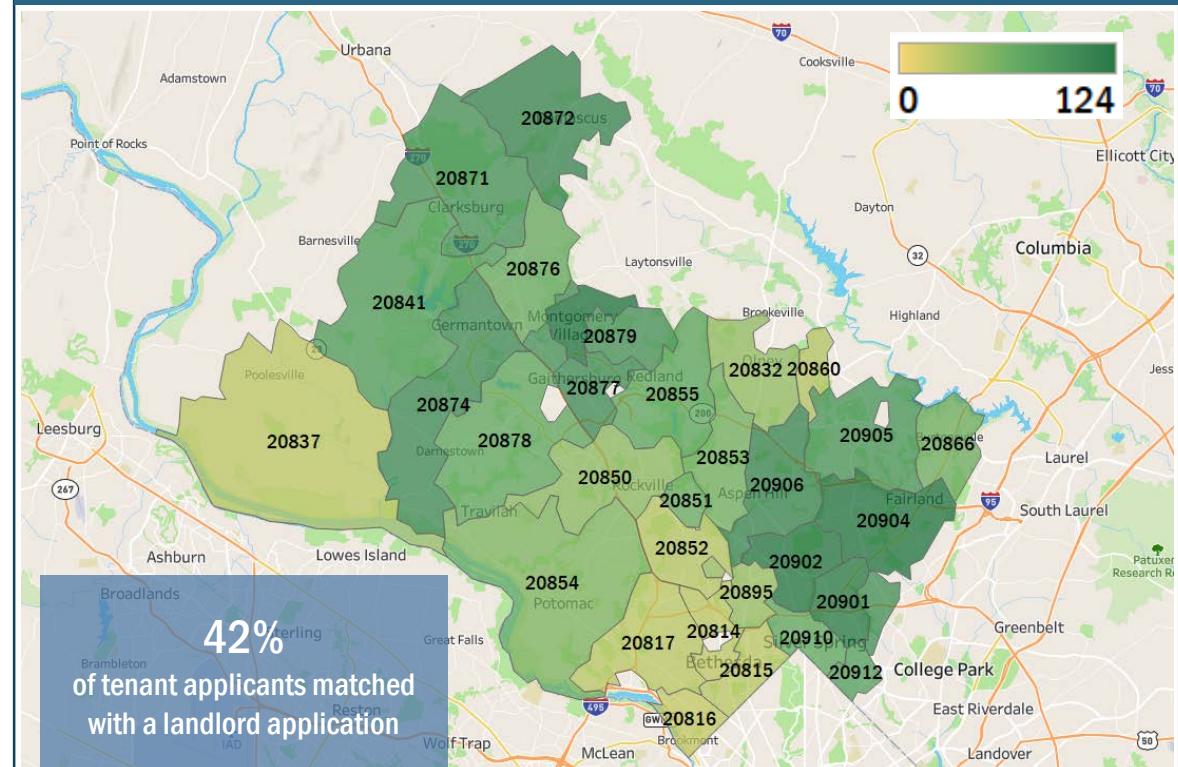

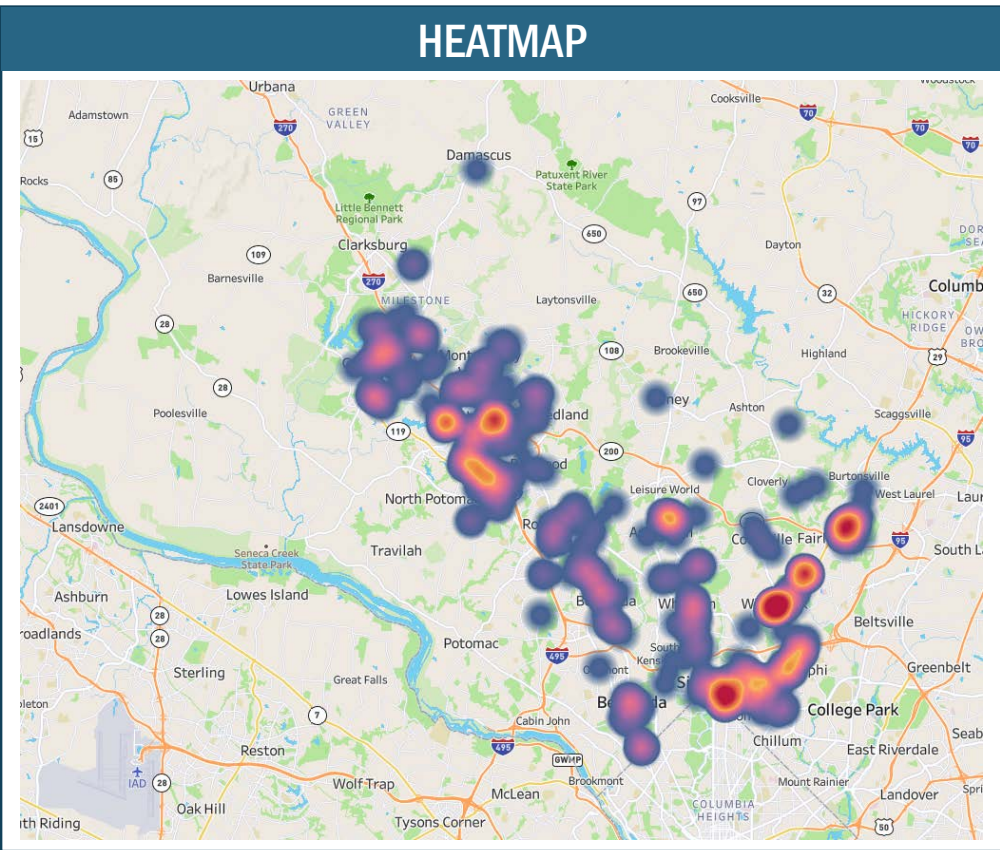

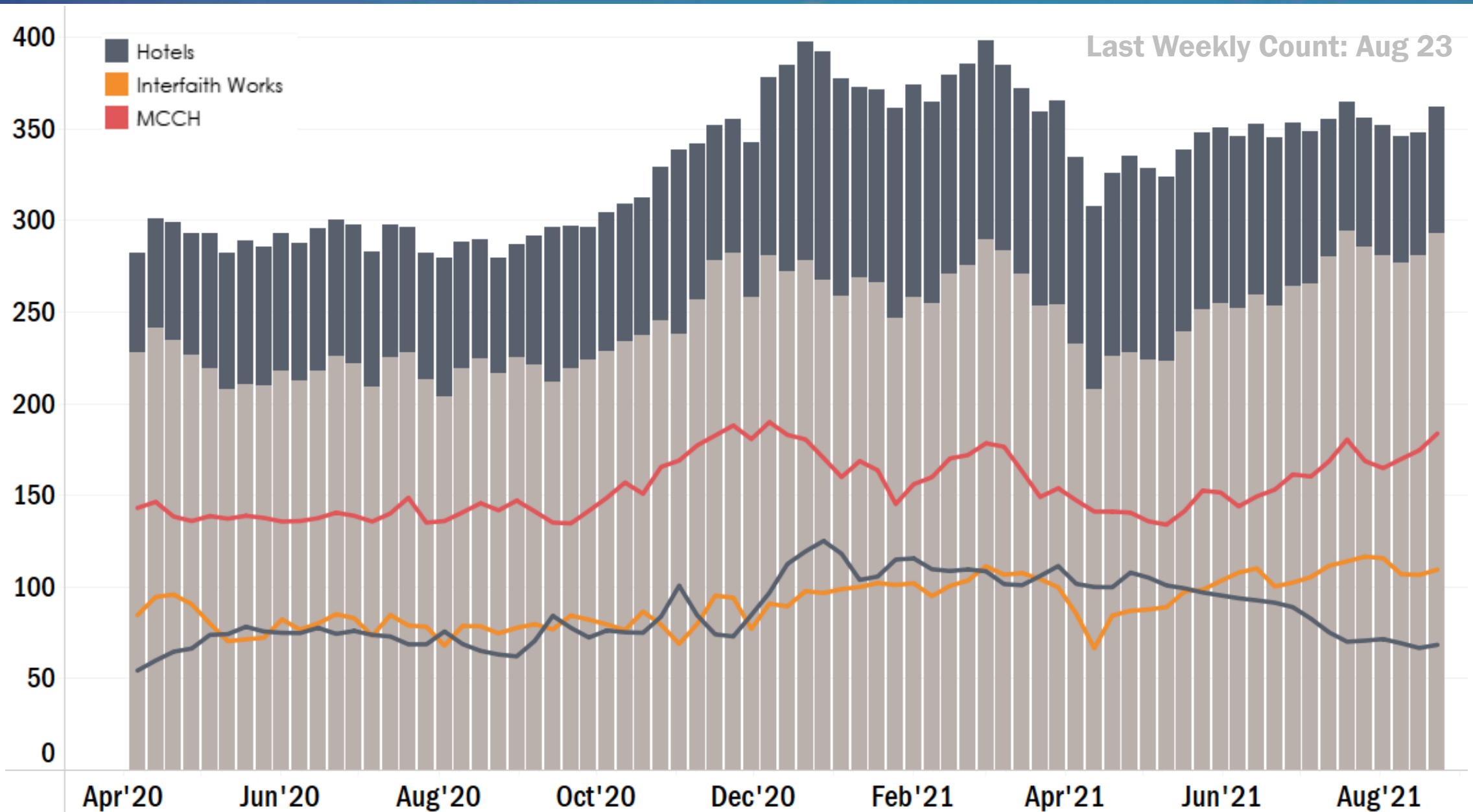

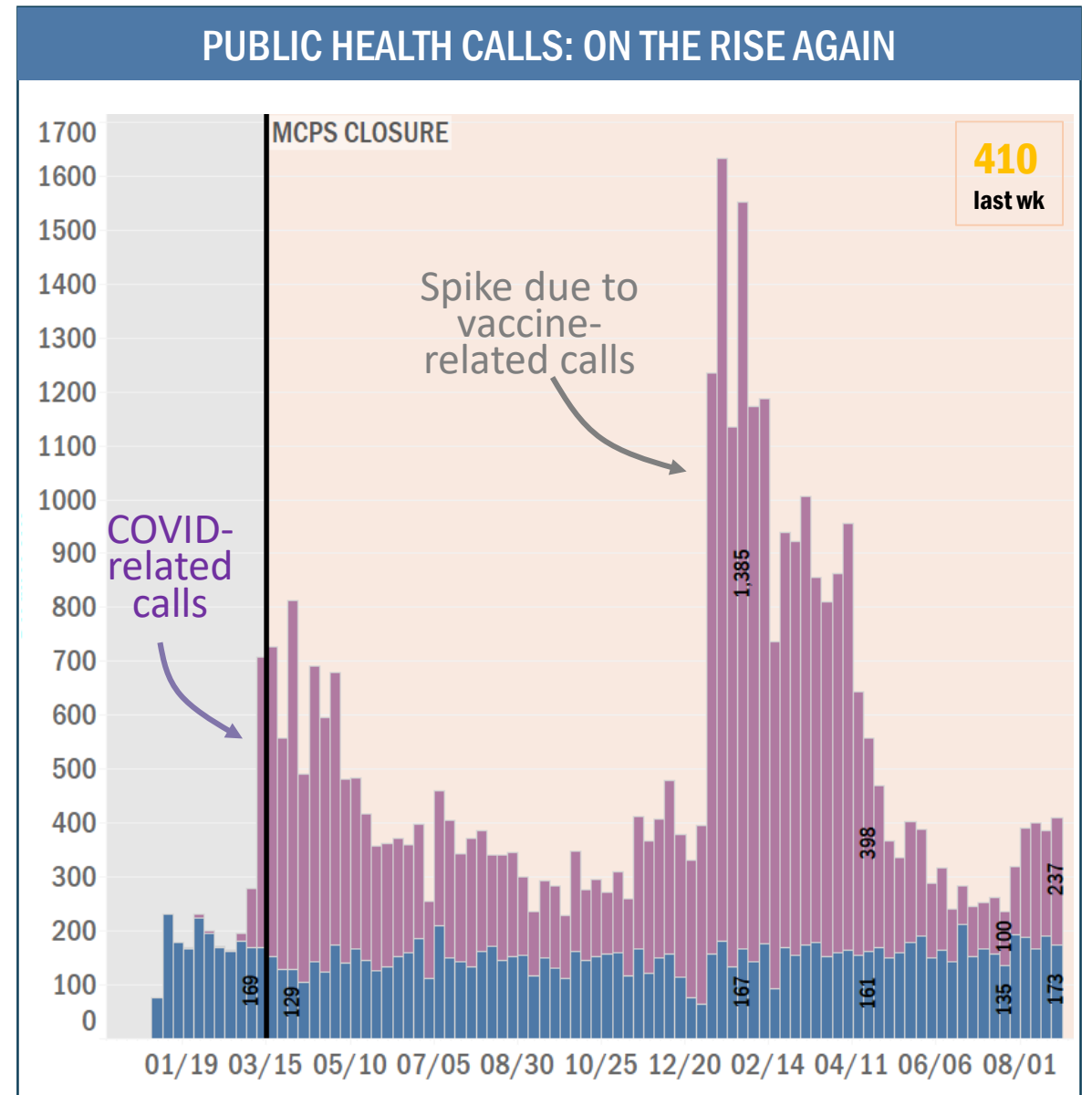
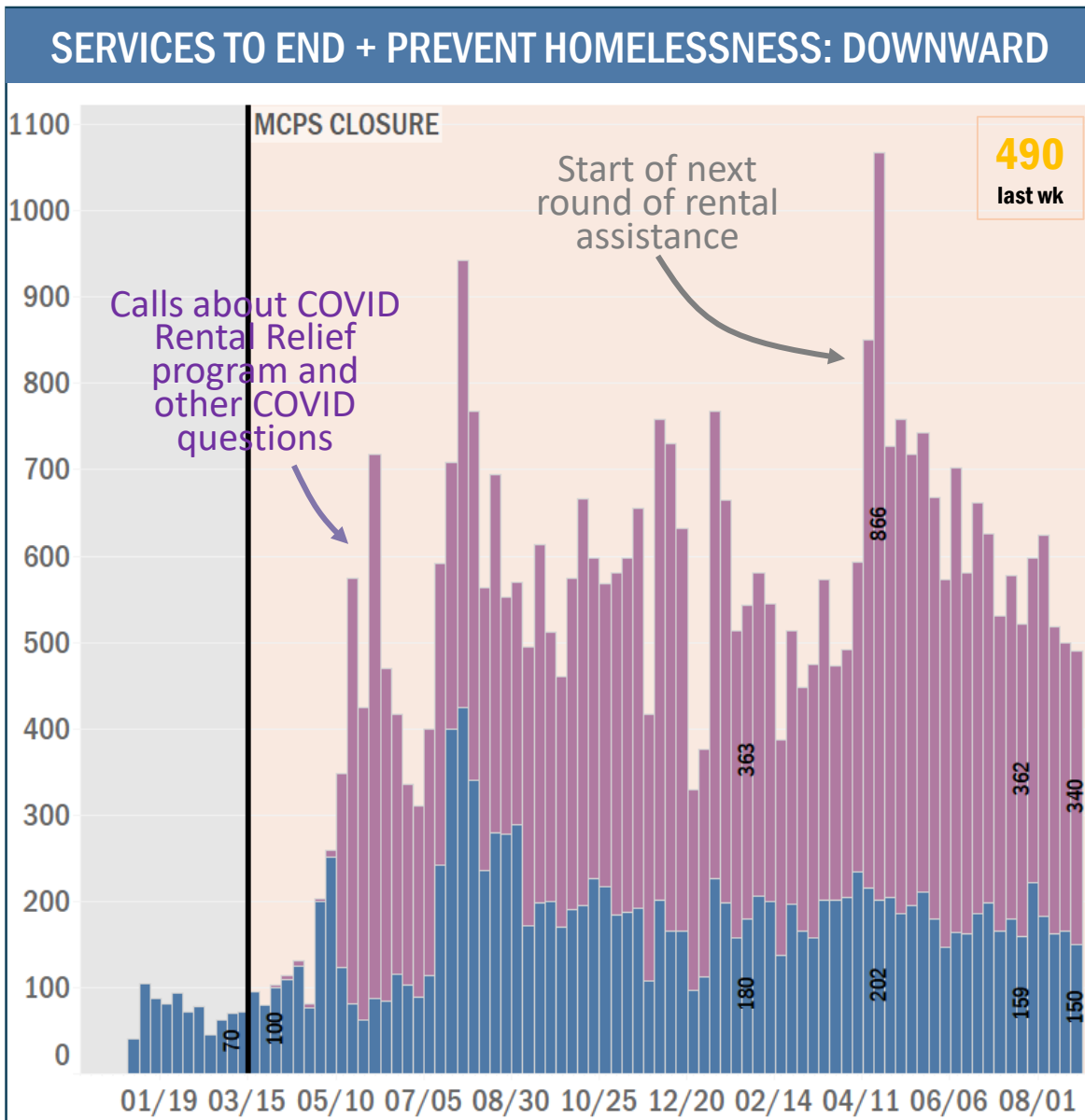

# SHELTER RESIDENTS: AVERAGE DAILY COUNT BY WEEK

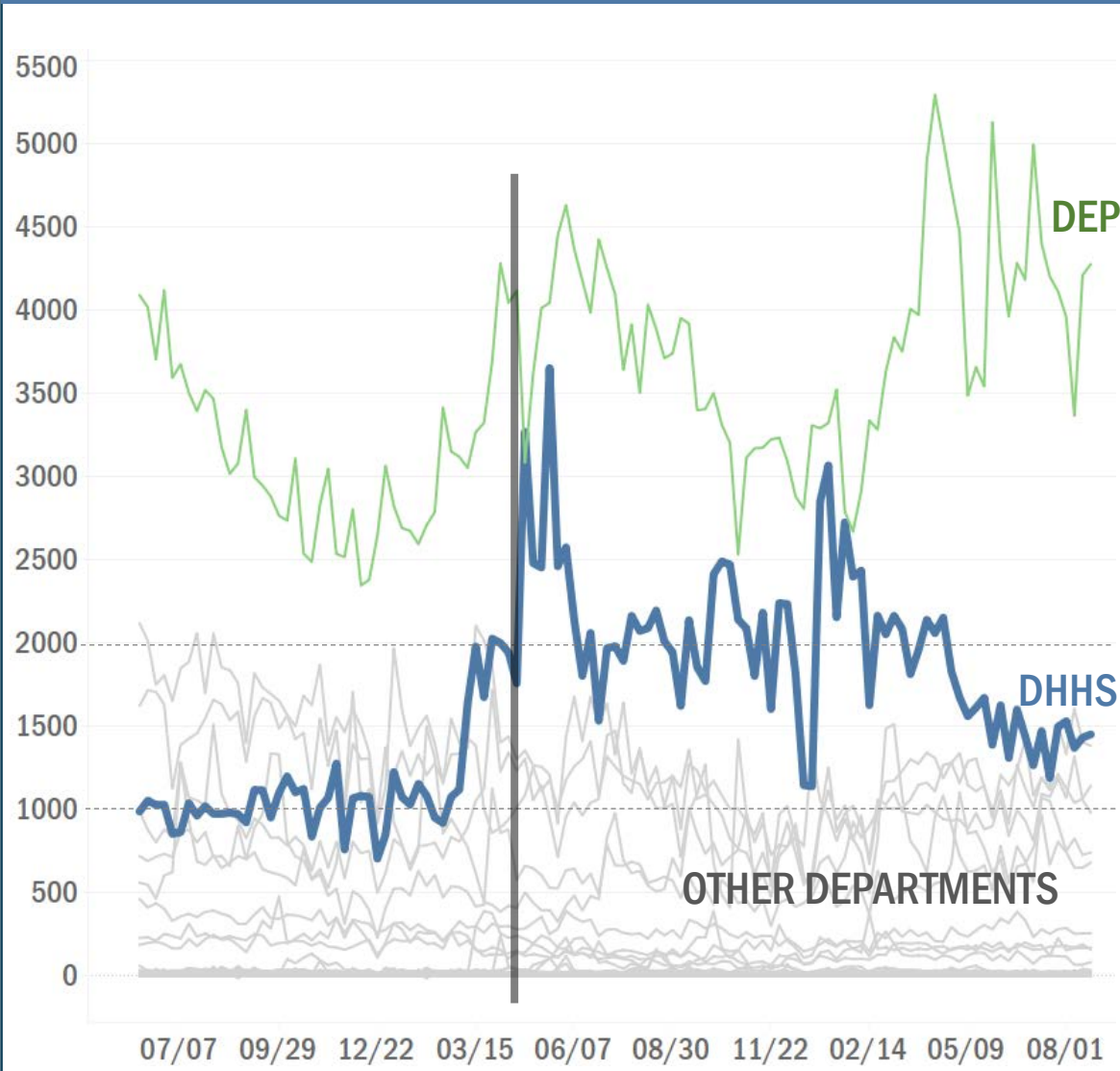


# MC311 WEEKLY CALL VOLUME

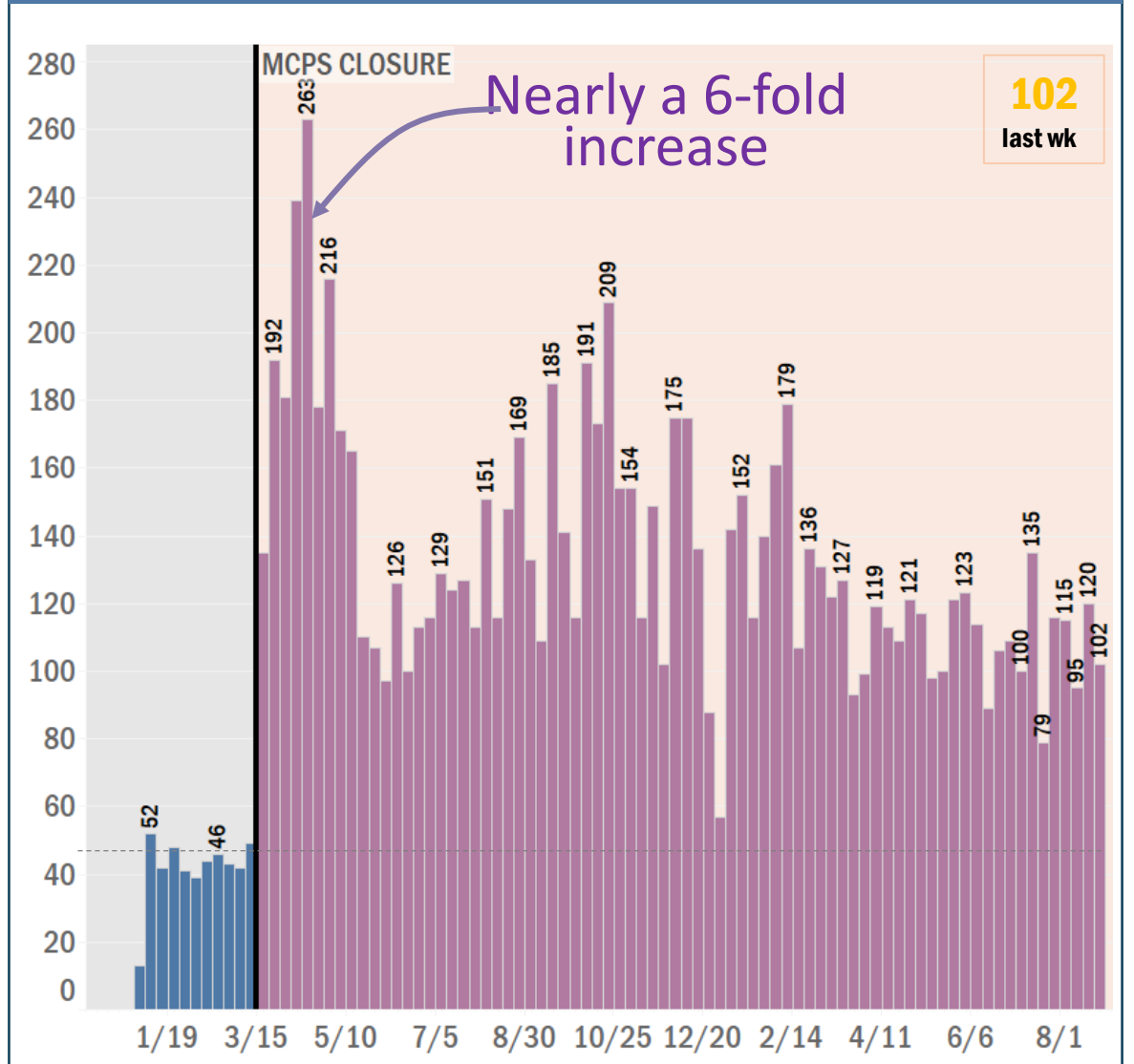

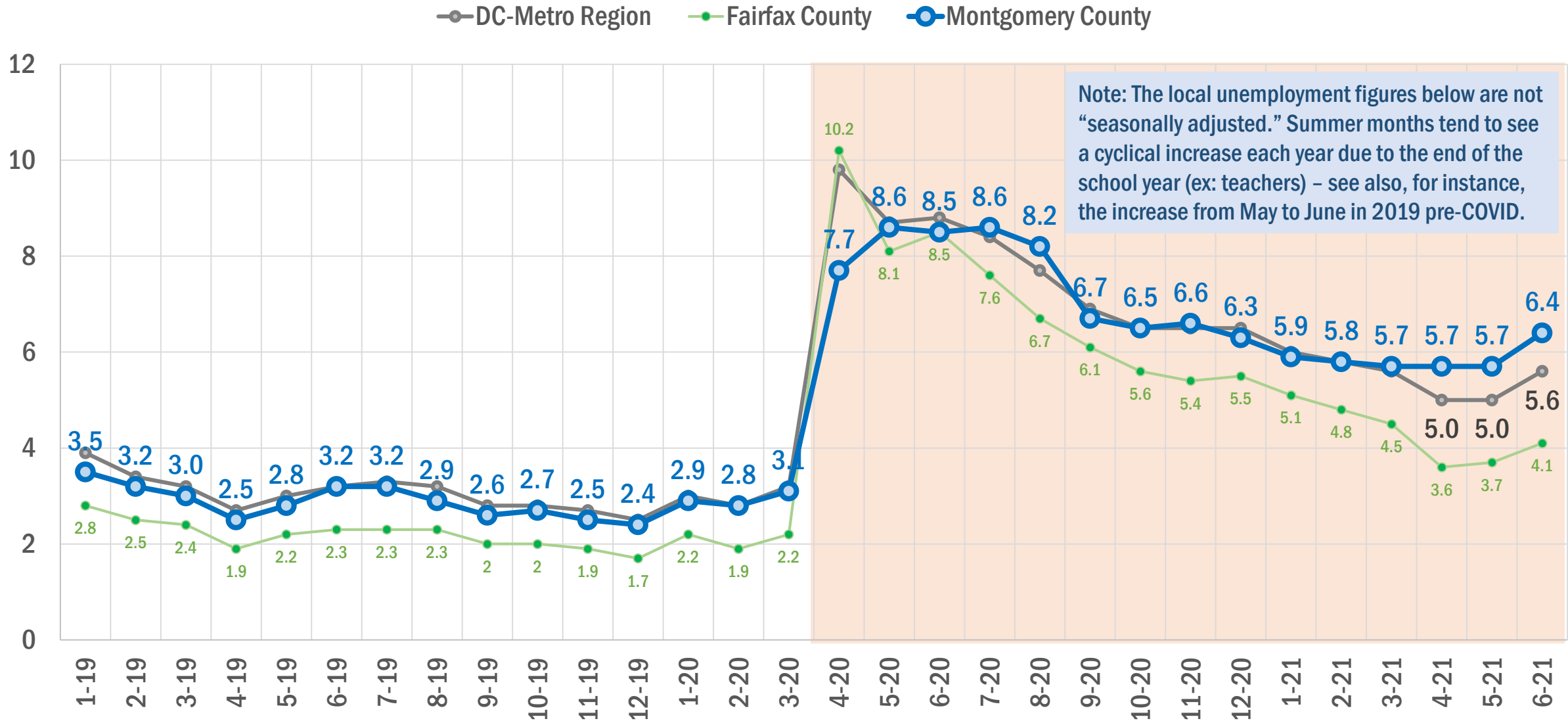

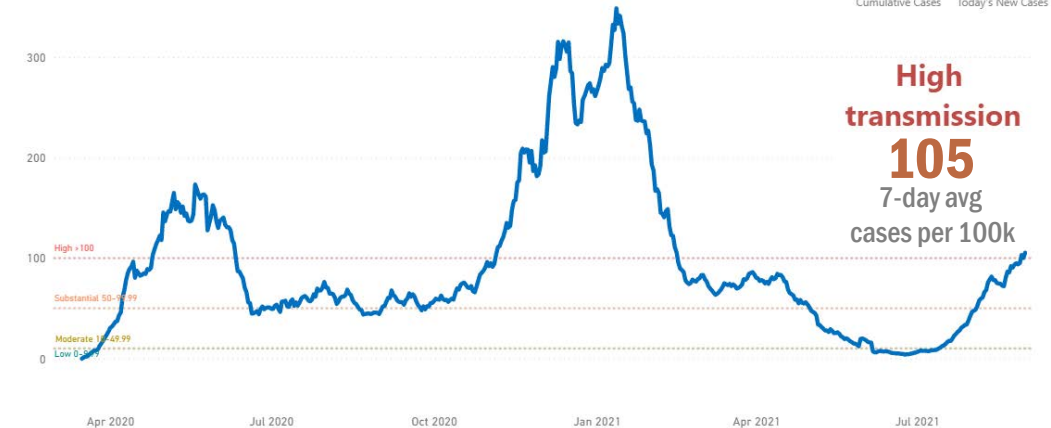

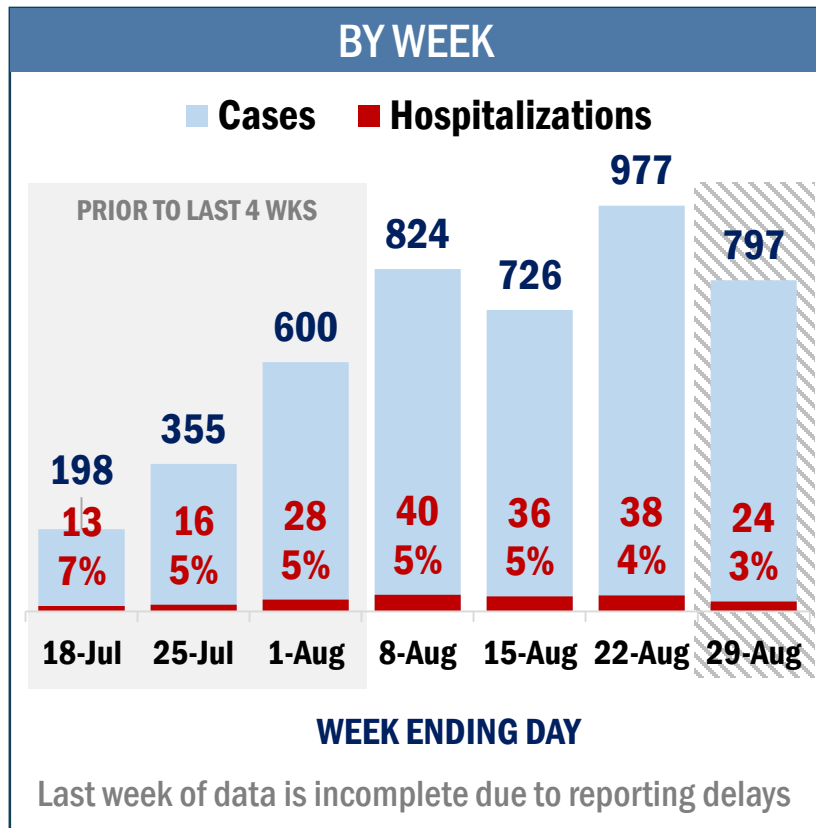

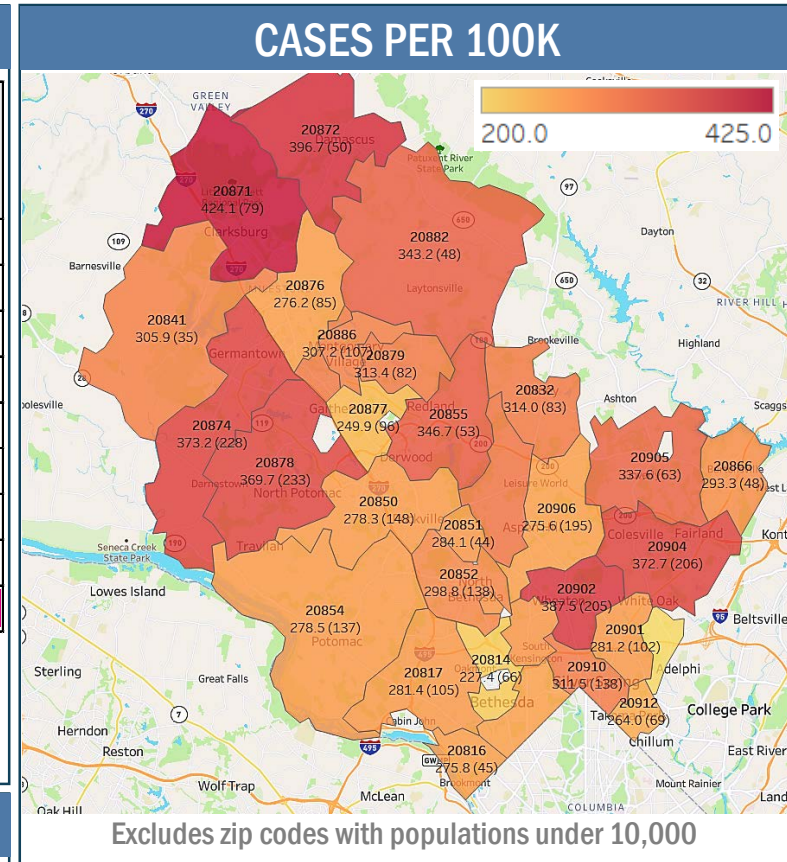

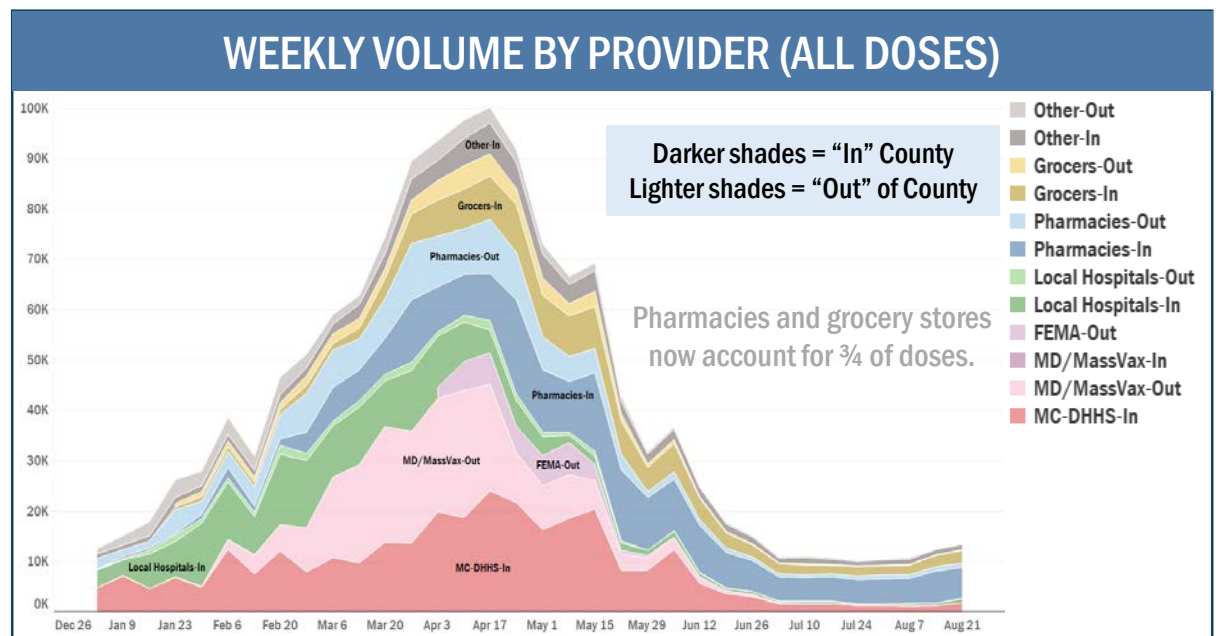

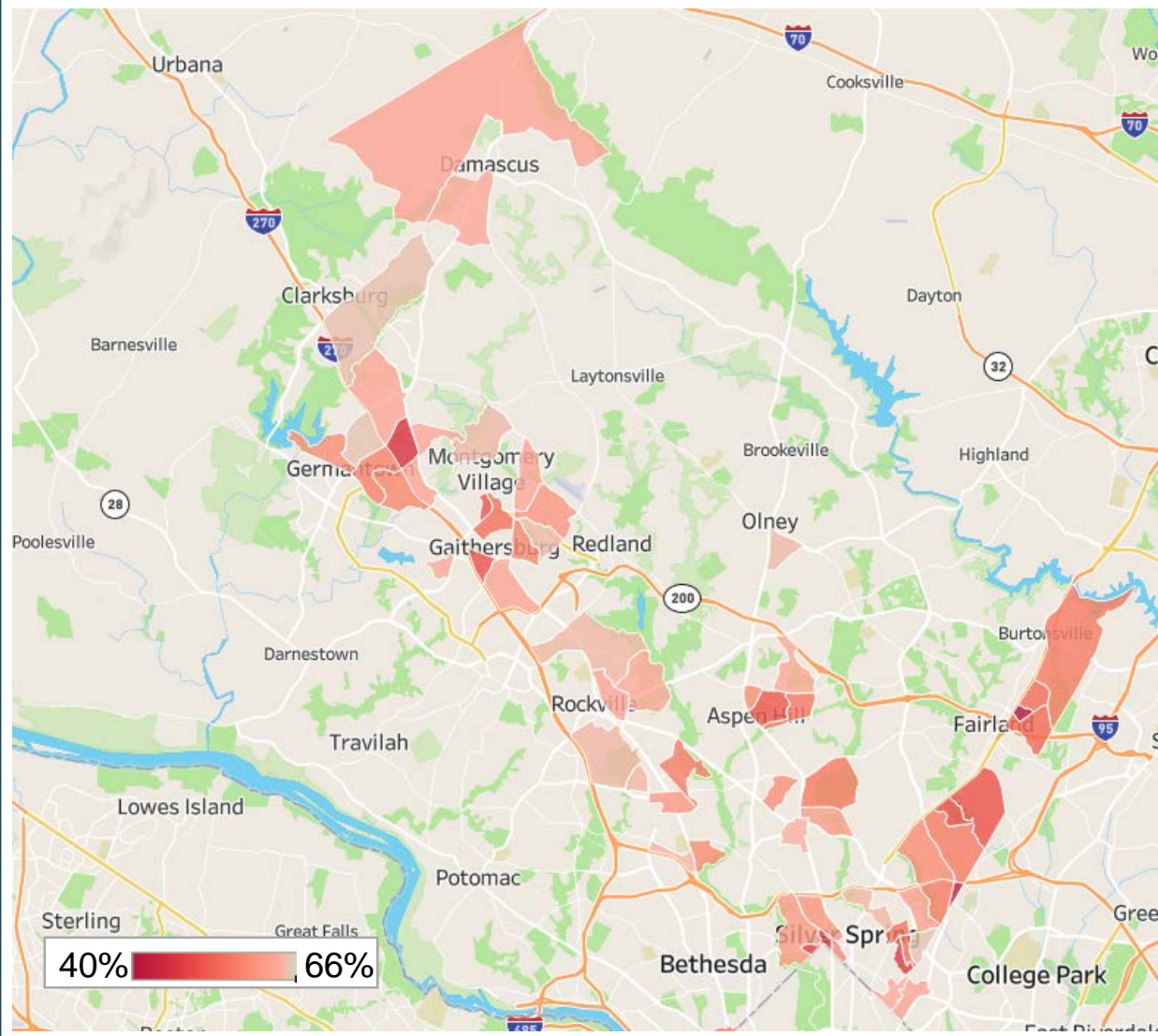
# VACCINATIONS: CHANGE OVER TIME AND BY AGE GROUP



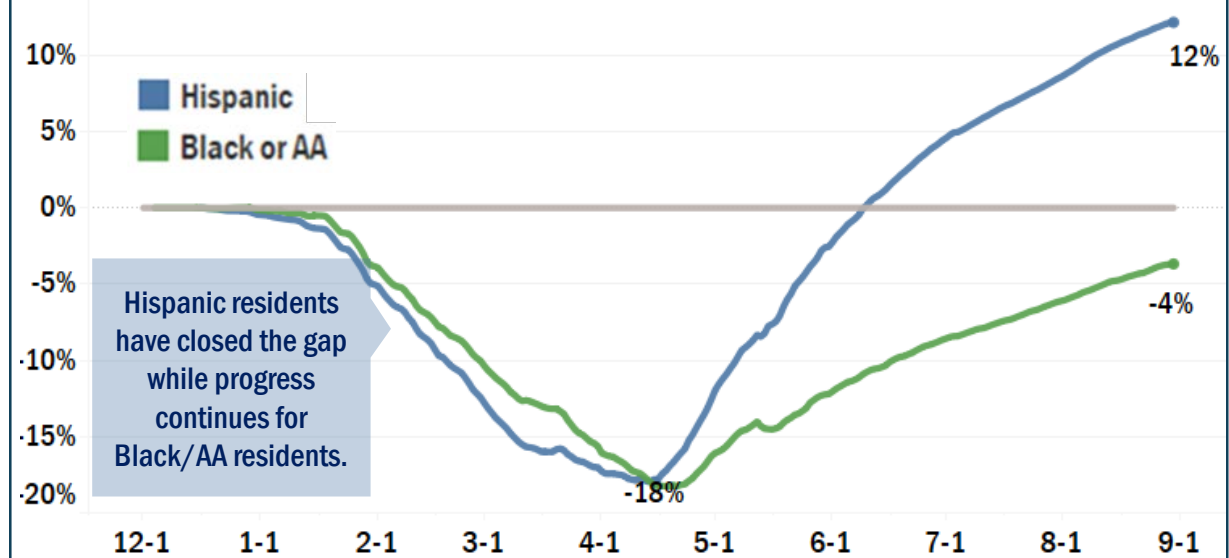

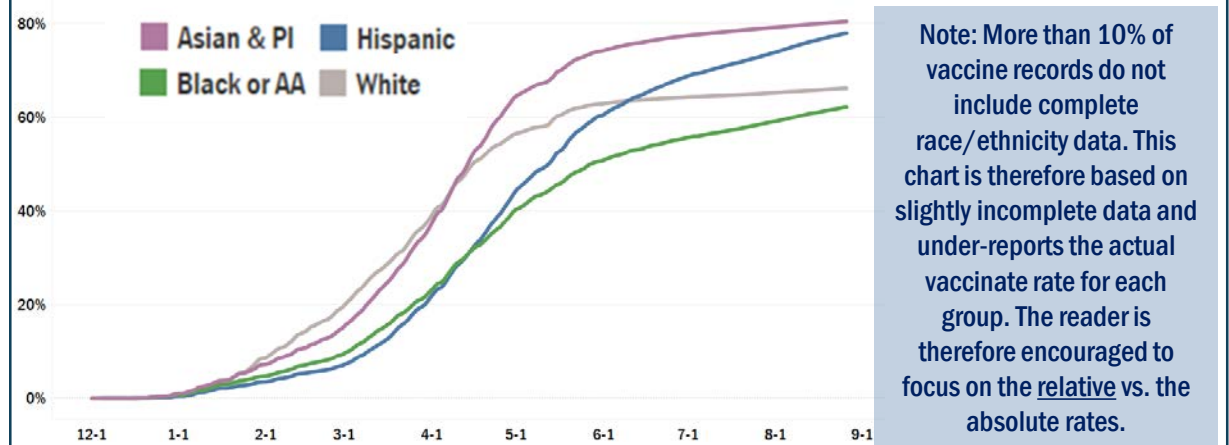
## TRACTS WITH BELOW-AVERAGE FIRST DOSE VAX RATES (ALL AGES)

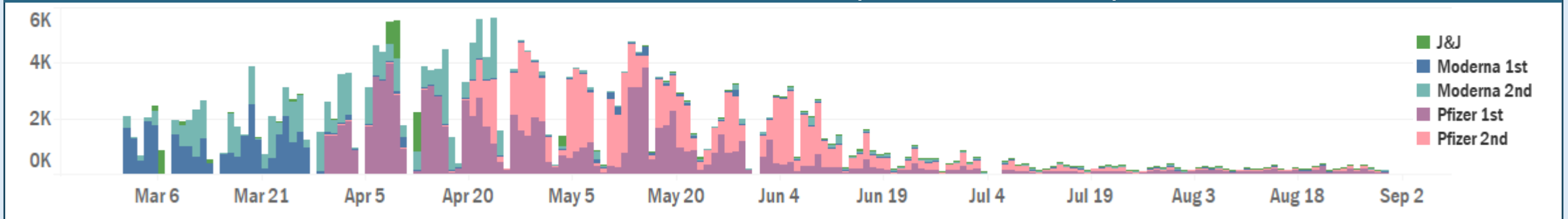
