



Parkvale Road has 60feet of total public right of way. The roadway is 26-feetwide, leaving 34-feet of total available right of way or 17-feet of right of way on each side of the road.

PROJECT JUSTIFICATION

- MCDOT evaluates requests for pedestrian facilities based on their ability to serve a public use and enhance public safety.
- Sidewalk Program Goal: To remove pedestrians from the path of vehicular traffic and create a separation between the pedestrian and the roadway.
- Sidewalks will connect to existing network of sidewalks and provide safer pedestrian access to schools, public transportation and other pedestrian attractions.



TREE REMOVAL & REPLACEMENT


- The removal of 47 trees is anticipated to facilitate the construction of sidewalks. Two additional trees will be removed because they were previously slated for removal due to poor health.
- 3 trees will be planted for every 1 tree removed or 141 trees will be planted back into the public right of way on Parkvale and Manorvale Roads and Greenspan Lane. Any overflow trees that do not fit back into the proposed roadways will be planted throughout the Rock Creek Manor community.
- Placement of the trees is selected by the County Arborist.

COSTS & ASSESSMENTS

- The estimated cost for installing the Rock Creek Manor community sidewalks is approximately \$535,200 costs include construction, inspection, and administrative costs.
- Funding for this project will be provided under the County's Sidewalk Program, CIP No. 0506747
- Although sidewalk installation is statistically proven to augment property values, there are no
 properties considered to be specially benefited by the proposed improvement. Therefore, no
 properties are expected to be assessed.
