

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC HEARING


Hearing held pursuant to Section 49-53 of the Montgomery County Code

Display B Typical Cross-Section of Briardale Road Sidewalk

Briardale Road has 60-feet of total public right of way. The roadway is 35-feetwide, leaving 25-feet of available right of way or 12.5-feet of right of way on both sides of the road.




Display C Typical Cross-Section of Baederwood Lane Sidewalk

Baederwood Lane has 60-feet of total public right of way. The roadway is 20-feet-wide, leaving 40-feet of available right of way or 20feet of right of way on both sides of the road.




Display D Typical Cross-Section of Bethayres Road Sidewalk

Bethayres Road has 60-feet of total public right of way. The roadway is 23-feet-wide, leaving 37-feet of available right of way or 18.5feet of right of way on both sides of the road.



Display E Typical Cross-Section of Dace Drive Sidewalk

Dace Drive has 60feet of total public right of way. The roadway is 26-feetwide, leaving 34-feet of available right of way or 17-feet of right of way on both sides of the road.



Display F Typical Cross-Section of Frontenac Terrace Sidewalk

Frontenac Terrace has 60-feet of total public right of way. The roadway is 23-feet-wide, leaving 37-feet of available right of way or 18.5-feet of right of way on both sides of the road.



PROJECT JUSTIFICATION

- MCDOT evaluates requests for pedestrian facilities based on their ability to serve a public use and enhance public safety.
- The main goal for installing a sidewalk is to remove pedestrians from the path of vehicular traffic and create a separation between the pedestrian and the roadway.






TREE REMOVAL & REPLACEMENT

- The removal of 23 trees is anticipated to facilitate the construction of sidewalks.
- 3 trees will be planted for every 1 tree removed or 69 trees will be planted back into the public right of way on Briardale Road, Baederwood Lane, Bethayres Road, Frontenac Terrace and Dace Drive. Any excess trees that do not fit back into the proposed roadways will be planted throughout the Parkside Estates community.
- The placement of the trees is selected by the County Arborist.

COSTS & ASSESSMENTS

- The estimated cost for installing the Parkside Estates Community sidewalks is approximately \$845,848.45. Estimated costs include construction, inspection, and administrative costs.
- Funding for this project will be provided under the County's Sidewalk Program, CIP No. 0506747
- Although sidewalk installation is statistically proven to augment property values, there are no properties considered to be specially benefited by the proposed improvement. Therefore, no properties are expected to be assessed.


