

What is Lifeline? The Lifeline Program will provide up to an additional \$9.25 per month off your phone or internet bills or your combined phone and internet bill.

How to Sign Up For The Lifeline Benefit



What is the difference between ACP and Lifeline?

You must have a lower income to qualify for Lifeline than for ACP. You must be enrolled in one of 5 benefit programs to qualify for Lifeline, but there are 8 benefits programs you can use to enroll in ACP.

Can I get both ACP and Lifeline?

Yes, if you are eligible for both, you can receive both benefits. For example, if you qualify for both, you could apply both discounts together and get up to \$59.25 off your home or mobile internet bill, or you could use the ACP to get up to \$45 off your home internet bill and get \$9.25 off your mobile telephone or internet bill.

Why should I sign up for Lifeline?

Some providers offer a free phone or discounted computer for Lifeline customers, but not for ACP customers. You can also receive additional saving off your home or mobile telephone bill. You cannot use ACP for regular phone service, only for home internet or internet on your mobile phone.



START BY ENTERING YOUR IDENTIFICATION INFORMATION

Scan the QR code or go to www.lifelinesupport.org to start an application for the Lifeline Program. The web link will direct you to the USAC Lifeline Support page. Scroll down and click on the button "Apply Now" to start.




2 Enter in your name exactly how it appears on your Government ID (Driver's License, Passport, Social Security Card, etc.)



For your date of birth choose your birth month and enter in the 2-digit day and the 4-digit year. (Example: January 09, 1982)




Use your Social Security Number (SSN) or Government ID to verify your identity. You do not need a SSN to apply. If using SSN, enter the last four digits. If using government ID, take a photo or use a device with a camera to upload a picture of a government ID (driver's license, passport, etc.).



5 Enter your address.

In the "State" box select "MD" for Maryland.







- You must choose if you qualify because YOU are enrolled in a benefit program (such as SNAP, Medicaid, WIC, SSI) or your income, or because YOUR CHILD or dependent is enrolled in a program (such as Medicaid or free school lunch).
 - If you will qualify because through your child's enrollment in a benefit program, enter your child's name as it appears on legal documents.
 - Enter their birthday (select Month, use two digits for day, and 4 digits for year).
 - Add the last four digits of their social security number or upload a picture of your child's government ID.


NOW CREATE AN ACCOUNT

- 7 Create your account. Use your email address as your username and create a password. Make sure your password is at least 8 characters long, has at least 1 capital letter, at least 1 number, and 1 or more special characters (!@#\$%^&*). Retype your password.
 YOU CAN SAVE YOUR USERNAME AND PASSWORD as a Contact (such as "Internet") in your phone.
- 8 Enter your email address and phone number. Click in the box "I'm not a robot" and then click "Submit".




Enter the username and password you just created.

Click "I'm not a robot" and then click "Sign In".


10 A Welcome screen will pop-up with your name on top. Scroll down and click "Start Lifeline Application".




Review your information and confirm that it is correct. If you need to make a correction, select the Edit button and follow the prompts to make your changes.











After you'll be taken to a section certifying that all the information is correct. Write your 2 letter Initials (first letter of first and last name, no middle initials) in each field, then at the end Sign by typing your full legal name, check the "Digital Signature" box, and click "Submit".



After you click "Submit", a screen will appear telling you you've been enrolled or that your information is being reviewed. Your "Application ID" number will be provided near your name and address.
