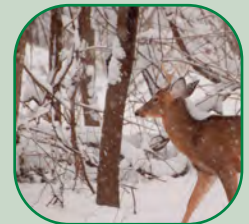

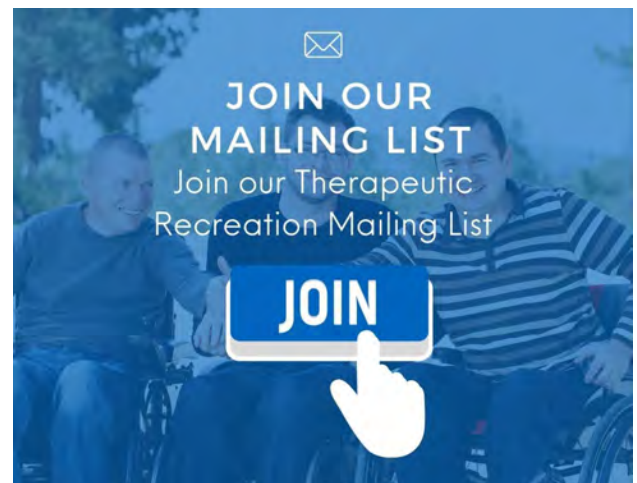

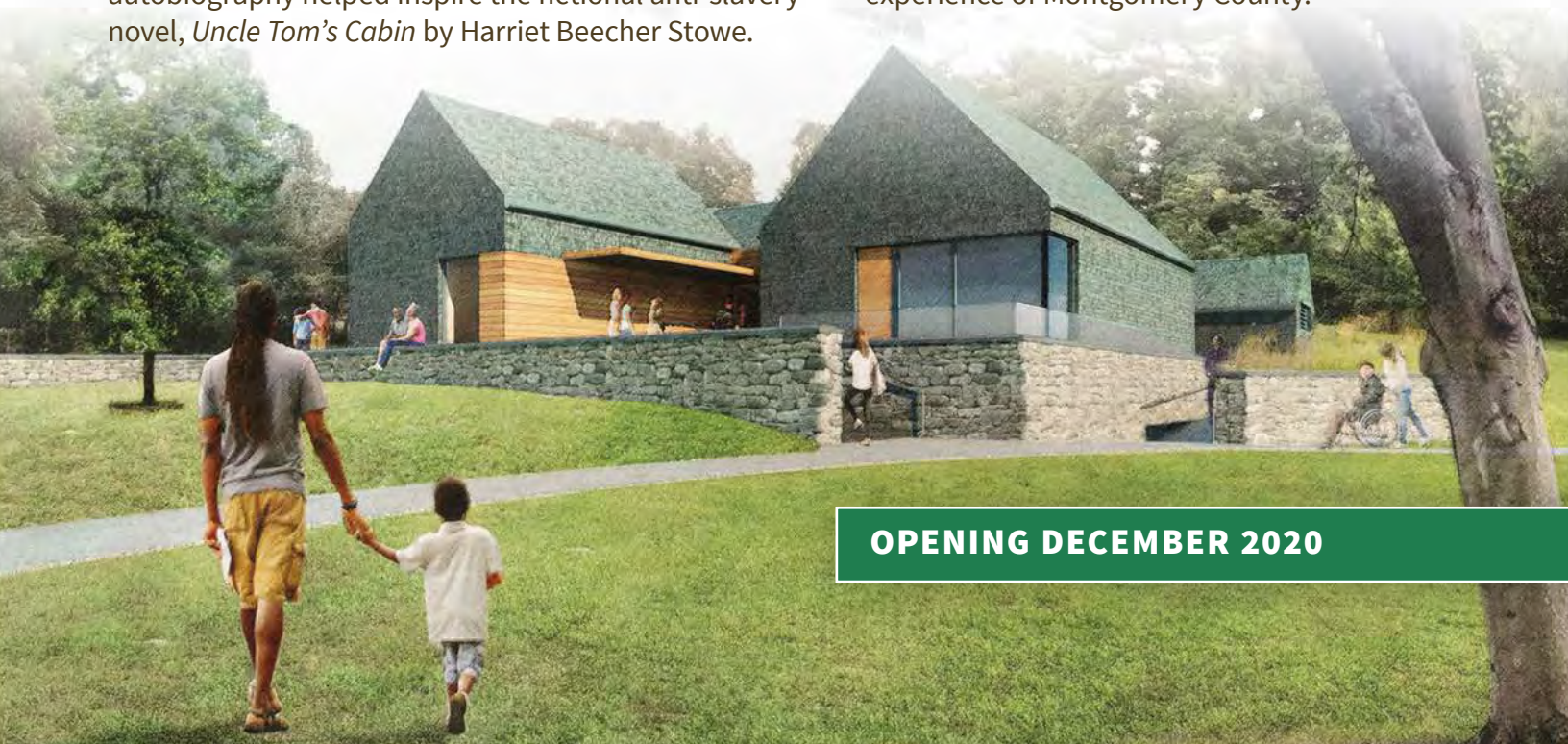


Josiah Henson Museum & Park
