5 Things You Should Know If You

MISSED A COURT HEARING

- Do not give up! If you received a deportation order for missing a hearing, you can ask the judge to rescind the deportation order and reopen your case.
- You should find a lawyer that can help you submit a petition as soon as possible.
- It is important to start NOW. The process will take time and you are more likely to reopen your case if you submit the petition before 180 days – or 6 months – of the missed hearing.
