## 5 Things You Should Do

## WHEN YOU MOVE

- If you have your asylum application or any other application pending with USCIS, you must change your address with USCIS.
- If you have, or are going to have, immigration court hearings, you must change your address using Form E-33.
- If you have court hearings and have moved far away, you may also have to file a petition asking to move your court to another city.
- If you have appointments with ICE or ASAP, you must inform your office of your address.
