Green Streets are roadway Low Impact Development (LID) designs that reduce and filter rainfall and pollutants that wash off surface areas (stormwater runoff), and enter our streams, degrading the water quality of our local streams and rivers. As of June 2012, the Montgomery County Department of Environmental Protection completed 24 new Green Streets LID practices throughout the Forest Estates neighborhood for enhanced stormwater management.

The Green Streets LID features provide environmental benefits, improve property aesthetics where reasonably possible, and provide community education opportunities. Installations include rain gardens, bioretention gardens, and bioswales.

The Forest Estates project area has also been identified as a Targeted RainScapes Neighborhood, which means that the residents have the option to install rain gardens, rain barrels, and other stormwater control features on their property, and have costs covered by the County.
