CCSCentral to complete an application for the state
CCS. Also provide program information and counseling with regards to choosing quality childcare, the pursuit of child support and other resources.

Family navigators assist parents and other primary caregivers by helping them successfully navigate the child-serving systems and supporting them in their relationship with those formal and informal supports involved in their lives. Services include linking families with assessment/evaluation and resources; assisting family members in organizing and preparing for meetings so that their voice is heard; going with family members to meetings, such as at school, court, hospitals, and social service agencies; communicating with the referral sources; and support groups, educational programs, and other family activities.
