Those eligible for MCHP are uninsured whose household modified adjusted gross income (MAGI) is at or below 211% of the federal poverty level (FPL) for their family size. Medicare Part D: Fully dual eligible Medicare beneficiaries receive most drugs excluded from Medicare Coverage -- All other drugs are provided by Medicare Prescription Drug Programs (PDPs). Please note that beginning 01/01/2013, drug coverage for Benzodiazepines and Barbiturates for those patients that are both Medicaid and Medicare eligible, will be provided by Medicare Part D Prescription Drug Plans and not the Maryland Medicaid Pharmacy Program. This change may cause patient co-payments to vary.

Pfizer Patient Assistance Program provides free Pfizer medicines to eligible patients through their doctor's office or at home. To qualify, patients must: have a valid prescription for the Pfizer medicine for which they are seeking assistance; have no prescription coverage, or not enough coverage, to pay for their Pfizer medicine; reside in the U.S. or a U.S. territory; meet income guidelines, which vary by medicine, but start at 400% of the Federal Poverty Level, adjusted for family size; and be treated by a healthcare provider licensed in the U.S. or a U.S. territory.

Pfizer Institutional Patient Assistance Program provides eligible, uninsured patients with free Pfizer medicines‡ through select federally qualified health centers, disproportionate share hospitals, and free clinics throughout the country. To be eligible to receive free medicine from a participating healthcare facility, patients must: have no prescription coverage; be at or below 400% of the Federal Poverty Level, adjusted for family size; reside in the U.S. (migrant and homeless patients are presumed eligible); have a valid prescription from a healthcare provider licensed in the U.S.; and be a registered outpatient of the participating healthcare facility.
