Thank you for your interest in being a foster parent with Montgomery County, MD! Please review the checklist below. You must meet all requirements to be considered to become a foster parent.

FOSTER AND ADOPTIVE PARENT SERVICES

To be a foster parent...

- 1. You must be a U.S. citizen or legal permanent resident
- 2. You must reside within Montgomery County, MD
- 3. Your income must exceed your financial needs/expenses
- 4. You cannot have been convicted of a felony or violent crime
- 5. You cannot have experienced a substance-use disorder or received treatment for a substance-use disorder within the past five years. If you have ever abused substances, you must provide documentation of successful completion of a treatment program
- 6. You must be 21 years old or older.
- 7. You must never have been indicated for child abuse or neglect
- 8. Your home must have more than one bedroom
- 9. You must either own your home, or be named on the lease to rent your home
- 10.You must be in good physical and mental health. Applicants over the age of 60 years will be asked to complete a medical form before beginning the licensing process
- 11. You must have a stable home life
