

LIBRARY DESIGN & FEATURES ADDED:

- + ADA upgrade of parking spaces
- + New combined information and circulation customer service desk
- + Enhanced preschool children's space with new shelving
- + Separate Teen Area with seating and collection
- + 3 collaboration spaces for up to 6 individuals
- + ADA upgrade of the staff and public restrooms
- + Selective new furniture
- + Painting
- + Selective replacement of carpet
- + Outside green space made accessible for programs
- + Additional electrical outlets

SIZE:

15,710 total gross square feet, including a 12,420 gross square foot main floor and a 3,290 gross square foot lower level.

SITE:

The existing library is located on Meadow Hall Drive, near its intersection with Viers Mill Road. The existing building was refreshed on its interior to provide a new circulation/information desk, millwork in the staff lounge, new paint and floor finishes throughout the building, the addition of two collaboration spaces, renovations to the staff and public toilet rooms and reorganization of shelving and furniture.

PARKING:

- 46 parking spaces for cars, including 4 ADA accessible parking spaces

BOOKS & MATERIALS:

- Over 80,000 print volumes
- Access to online databases

TECHNOLOGY:

- 12 Internet PCs and 1 catalog PC in the Adult area
- 2 Internet PCs and 1 catalog PC in the Children's area
- 1 AWE workstation

- + Digital display near the Information Desk
- Under MCPL's ACE (All Children Excel) initiative, STEM related GO! Kits for checkout on science-based topics including "Little Explorers Go! Kits" for preschool children and "Young Voyagers Go! Kits" for elementary aged children
- Two self-checkout workstations
- + Tables in Teen and Adult Reading rooms
- + Enhanced WiFi
- + New technology including a 3D Printer, charging station for customers' mobile devices
