Vaccine Allocation Weekly Schedule

- Surveys are sent to Vaccine Providers each Monday asking how much vaccine each entity has and how much they want for the upcoming week
- Vaccine Allocation Planning Numbers are received from Feds to the State on Tuesdays. This lets us know how much vaccine the State will get the following week
- Allocation approvals received on Thursday through MDH. Orders are placed with Feds at 6pm each Thursday
- Friday order confirmation emails sent to Vaccine Providers

NOTE: 1&1 Pause has caused State allocations to go down

State Run Mass Vaccination Sites

- Six Flags America: 6,000 doses/day
- M&T Bank Stadium: 6,000 doses/day
- Wicomico Youth and Civic Center: 1,500 doses/day
- Regency Furniture Stadium: 6,000 doses/day
- Hagerstown Premium Outlets: 2,000 doses/day
- Baltimore Convention Center ($\frac{1}{2}$ testing, $\frac{1}{2}$ Vaccine), 1,000 doses/day

NOTE: All are 7 days a week except for BCC which is Mon-Sat

State Run, FEMA Supported Mass Vaccination Initiatives

- Greenbelt Metro Station: 3,000 doses a day; open 7 days a week
- Mobile Vaccination Trailers: 250 doses a day; 2 units; open Tuesday through Sunday. One on Eastern Shore and one in Western Maryland
- Vaccination Strike Teams: 100 doses a day; 6 units; open 6 days a week. Move throughout the State in coordination with LHDs. Specifically for underserved populations and rural areas

Locally Run, State Supported Mass Vaccination Sites

- Timonium Fairgrounds: 6 days a week (closed Fridays); 3,000 doses/day
- Frederick Community College: Schedule and doses/day vary
- Montgomery College: Monday through Friday; 3,000 doses/day
- Mall at Columbia: Wednesday through Sunday; 3,000 doses/day
- Ripken Stadium: Tuesday through Saturday; 3,000 doses/day
- Navy Stadium: Wednesday through Sunday; 3,000 doses/day
- Morgan State University: Friday, Saturday and Sunday; 125 doses/day
