Local park projects include, but are not limited to, construction of a picnic shelter at Aberdeen Local Park; improvements at Darnestown Square Urban Park; replace pergola and planters at Caroline Freeland Urban Park; and sewer improvements at various local parks. Non-local park projects include, but are not limited to, design and construction of a dog park at Olney Manor; improvements at Black Hill Maintenance Facility; parking lot lights at Olney Manor; and sewer design and construction at Meadowside Nature Center.

Park, Recreation, and Open Space Master Plan (PROS): A Local Land Preservation and Recreation Plan, approved by the Montgomery County Planning Board in July, 1998.
