fence that we see right here?
    HEARING EXAMINER: That was the existing
fence; correct?
    MS. SODHI: Yes.
    HEARING EXAMINER:And is there a permit
for that fence?
    MS. SODHI:There was. This fence was
put on a long time ago. So I have asked my dad to
see if he was able to come up with the permit.
But I was, I believe --
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    MS. KAUR: We do have a permit.
    MS. SODHI: Yes, we do have a permit.
    I just don't think Dad knows where it would be or
    if he has a notice of it or not.
    HEARING EXAMINER: Okay. I'm going to
    pull up staff's report. They have color photos
    that maybe can -- I don't know what page it is.
    Okay. So here we have the front of the house.
    Let me make this -- okay. Can you see that?
    MS. SODHI: Yes.
    HEARING EXAMINER: Okay. So the shorter
    fence, is that -- that's what needs to be
    replaced --
    MS. SODHI: Yes.
    HEARING EXAMINER: -- according to what
    I'm reading from staff; correct?
MS. SODHI: Absolutely, yes.
HEARING EXAMINER: To install the same
type of fence that's already there?
MS. SODHI: Yes.
HEARING EXAMINER: Okay.
MS. SODHI: He already had the contract
in place to get it replaced with the same material
and height as the other.
HEARING EXAMINER: Okay. And what about

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1 the -- where would the gate be? How would you -I mean, you say you have a contract. Do you have a plan for that?

MS. SODHI: So they are -- once I've
signed the contract, they will be getting the permits for that. That's part of their thing. So when you ask for the gate, if you can scroll down to, yes, this picture right here.

HEARING EXAMINER: Okay.
10 MS. SODHI: Yes, that right there. And what they plan to do is completely I guess take this fence off, the shorter fence, and then change it to the same height and material as the taller 14 fence. And where we see where the gates -- it 5 says "gate", they will put the actual fenced gate 16 there, and it will be the same height as the rest 17 of the fence as well.
18 HEARING EXAMINER: Okay. So it will be 19 secure?
20 MS. SODHI: Yes, absolutely.
21 HEARING EXAMINER: I was a little
2 concerned seeing the wire wrappings on the gate,
3 and, kind of short. But anyway, the deal is that
4 they're going to bring it out and place is exactly
where the 3.5 -foot fence is, but it's going to
match the existing 5.5-foot fence, and you're going to have a basically 5.5 -foot gate; correct?

MS. SODHI: Correct, yes.
HEARING EXAMINER: And will a new gate be
put on the back side, on the entrance, or will it
be the existing fence? Existing gate. Or -- let
me see if I can ... I think that -- let's see.
Will you be replacing the gate to the stairway to
the daycare entrance?
10 MS. SODHI: So what we're doing now is if 11 you can see the fence all the way to the back -okay. So I see that.

HEARING EXAMINER: Okay.
MS. SODHI: This gate is attached to the 15 fence on the left-hand side. We're actually going 16 to fence the entire property out all the way down 17 to the -- in the back, so that we wouldn't even 18 need this gate. Once a child is in, they're 19 securely within the premises and there's no way of 20 leaving unless they go out from that same gate.
21 So we'll take -- and we're actually just enclosing
22 the whole property. And they will get permits for 23 all of this.
24 HEARING EXAMINER: Okay. So right now, 25 so right now, that fence I'm looking at -- what is

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this, 17(d) -- you're saying that that black
fence, I mean, that black gate --
    MS. SODHI: Yes.
    HEARING EXAMINER: -- is going to
disappear, and you are going to fence in the
entire yard down to the rear. That metal fence
there, is that yours or is that what's being
replaced?
    MS. KAUR: No, that's next-door neighbor.
    MS. SODHI: Yes, and it goes back -- but
it does -- I guess the picture, the way it shows,
it shows the next-door neighbor's fence. But we
have the same going back into ours. Ours is
wooden, but it does connect from there and it goes
all -- and it wraps around. But now this fence
will then meet at the end of this, at the end of
the metal one.
    HEARING EXAMINER:Okay. So, let's see.
I'm going to pull up -- this is Exhibit 14, just
for clarity. Okay. 14. Okay. So this is what
you provided for the outline of the
neighborhood -- I mean, not the neighborhood; your
property.
    MS. SODHI: Right.
    HEARING EXAMINER: As you can see,
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    I don't have a very clear copy at all. All
    I have, what's pretty clear, is the dash line,
    which I'm assuming is the fence.
    MS. SODHI: Yes.
    HEARING EXAMINER: But everything else,
    as you can see, is very faint. So I'm going to
ask you -- I wish if we were in a courtroom, you
could make these changes right there to update
this with the proposed new fence and gate, because
10 this definitely does not depict that, what you
11 just described.
12 MS. SODHI: Okay. Can you tell me the
number again?
14 HEARING EXAMINER: Yes.
MS. SODHI: You said 14, Exhibit --
HEARING EXAMINER: 14. And it can be
hand-drawn, but I do need you to make it darker so
18 that I -- it's very faint.
19 MS. SODHI: It is, yeah.
20 HEARING EXAMINER: So if you need to
21 redraw it, but reflecting the change that you just
22 described, which is enclosing the entire backyard,
23 installing a 5.5 -foot gate at the front and
24 showing that the access to the daycare there, it
25 is fenced in, the area is fenced in.

MS. SODHI: If I can ask a question here. The gate, does that have to be five feet? Because maybe I'm not exactly sure. I know that it's going to be a tall gate, but it may be a 4.5 -foot, a 5-feet -- I don't think I have specifics. So I don't know if the --
11 HEARING EXAMINER: I don't think that it 12 has to be 5.5 feet. It just has to be secure and stable.
14 MS. SODHI: Okay.
15 HEARING EXAMINER: And that might be 16 a permitting issue in terms of whether you can, 7 you know -- whether it can be that way in the 18 front yard. So any other questions on what I need for this exhibit?

MS. SODHI: I think I'm clear on that.
1 Is there going to be an email afterwards just to,
2 I guess, for everything that we spoke of or what needs to be submitted?

HEARING EXAMINER: We'll talk about it 5 all at the end.

1 MS. SODHI: Okay. All right, got it.
HEARING EXAMINER: With regards to the easement, have you obtained the revocable agreement with the county, started the process, or what are you doing with that?

MS. SODHI: With the easement?
HEARING EXAMINER: Uh-huh.
MS. SODHI: Uh --
HEARING EXAMINER: Staff report, and that 10 you have a -- your fence is on a storm easement.

MS. SODHI: Oh, okay.
HEARING EXAMINER: And in order to put 13 something on there, you have to -- the county has 14 to have access, and I believe that if they -- they 15 will grant you that with the understanding that it 16 can be taken down in the event of an emergency. 17 But you have to have an agreement. Any approval 18 will be conditioned on you producing that 19 agreement from the county. Have you started that 20 process or you -- I mean, I know you just got the 21 staff report not too long ago.
22 MS. SODHI: Yes. I have not started that 23 process, but I have spoken to Ms. Katherine, who
24 did speak to someone I think in planning and 25 permitting, and they said that they would be --

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that it is a doable thing. So once we are
approved, then to start up the process of getting
the permit for that.
    HEARING EXAMINER: Okay. Just so that
you understand, any approval, you wouldn't be able
to start without proof that you have obtained
that, because I'm going to ask you to submit that
as part of the record so that it's in the file.
    MS. SODHI: Got it.
    HEARING EXAMINER: So that you have that.
Okay?
    MS. SODHI: Okay.
    HEARING EXAMINER: And certainly if you
find that there's going to be issues with that,
you would have to come back and say, "We have
issues with that," and then if you need to modify
it again. But again, just so we're clear, any
approval will be conditional on obtaining that and
that being part of the record.
    MS. SODHI: Got it.
    HEARING EXAMINER: Okay. With regards to
    parking, on-street parking. Do you have -- is --
    do you have unrestricted parking allowed in front
    of your house?
    MS. SODHI: Do we have any restricted
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    parking, you said? I'm sorry, I didn't get that.
    HEARING EXAMINER: Unrestricted. I mean,
    do you have any restrictions of parking on the
    house?
    MS. SODHI: No, no.
    HEARING EXAMINER: Okay, yeah. And how
    many spaces do you believe you have? How many
cars can you fit in front of your house?
MS. SODHI: So, not the driveway; we're
talking on the street?
HEARING EXAMINER: The street, yes.
MS. SODHI: Just the street? Geez. I'm
thinking -- we can easily, on just one side of the
street, have five cars parked at one time.
HEARING EXAMINER: Okay. With regards to
the bicycle requirement, I understand you've asked
for a waiver of the design.
MS. SODHI: Yes.
HEARING EXAMINER: And staff supported
that. I just wanted to make sure. But you have
space on the side of the house if someone does --
or inside the garage if somebody does --
MS. SODHI: Absolutely.
HEARING EXAMINER: But you did ask for
a waiver?

MS. SODHI: Yeah.
HEARING EXAMINER: Okay. And no sign.
I don't see any request for a sign, and you
understand that no sign will be permitted?
MS. SODHI: Yes.
HEARING EXAMINER: Okay. With regards to
the affidavit of compliance from the co-owner,
I understand, and I'm sorry to hear, that your --
Ms. Kaur, your family has been exposed to COVID.
I hope everybody remains healthy. I'm really
sorry to hear that. So I understand that you
can't get his affidavit notarized, because what
you submitted is not notarized. So if you need
time to get that, that's fine.
MS. SODHI: Thank you. Appreciate that.
HEARING EXAMINER: Fingers crossed that
17 everybody makes it through the quarantine period.
MS. SODHI: Thank you.
HEARING EXAMINER: I don't have any other
0 questions that I -- I don't have any other
questions. Do you have any further questions,
Ms. Sodhi, and then I'll ask Ms. Kaur?
MS. SODHI: No, I think I'm pretty clear 4 on these, thank you.

HEARING EXAMINER: Ms. Kaur?

1 MS. KAUR: No, thank you.
HEARING EXAMINER: Do you have your childcare license?

MS. KAUR: It is downstairs in the
basement, so ...
HEARING EXAMINER: We'll just add that to
the list, if you could just send it so we can make
it part of the record. Again, knowing that you
will file for one that allows you to have up to 12 10 children, whatever the state requirements are.
11 I'm going to just throw it out there.
