to clear the air from where we left off in the past hearing, which also explains why I was at the meeting on the 19th.

We had a civic association meeting on the 17th. The School and its representatives attended. And as I expected, the neighborhood objected to having the restrictions, the U-turn restrictions, in place on Old Georgetown Road and the left-turn restrictions and voted in opposition to them.
11 The one -- during the discussion, one of 12 the residents of Spruce Tree Road spoke. He 13 said we've lived with this for a long time. We 14 know there's going to be a problem getting out 15 and making a left turn, but the light signals -16 there's a space between the signalization of the 17 lights at Beech Avenue and West Cedar Lane that 18 allows us to get out. We just have to wait a 19 little bit and we get out, and we don't have a 20 problem. And they all said basically we don't 21 see a need for the restrictions and we would 22 object to them, and that's what I brought to the 23 meeting on the 19th.
24 MS. HANNAN: Okay. Great. Anything else 25 you want to comment on?

MR. MYERS: No. I appreciate -- I think we -- as a neighborhood, I think there's a -- we understand the need for the school and we're hopeful that the studies don't show any problems and we don't wind up having to deal with the issues, these issues, again, and I hope that everything goes smoothly.

MS. HANNAN: Well, I hope that SHA looks at 9 this globally to alleviate concerns, but that's 10 just me and not SHA. So, I do appreciate all 11 your input and working with the Applicant.
12 MR. MYERS: I appreciate you giving me the 13 opportunity.
