

MAP-21 Agricultural Exemptions

Below is a chart of questions and answers to new MAP-21 Agricultural Exemptions.



Section 32101(d) of MAP-21 exempts the transportation of agriculture commodities and farm supplies from the federal hours of service rules during the states designated harvest season within a 150 air mile radius from the source (it is now 100 air miles for CDL vehicles).

Section 32934 of MAP-21 exempts operators of “covered farm vehicles” from the following CFR’s-

**383- CDL’s
382- Drug & Alcohol Testing
391- Medical Examiners Certification
395- Hours of Service
396- Inspection, Repair & Maintenance**

The term “covered farm vehicle” includes any commercial motor vehicle defined in 49 CFR 390.5, (but excluding vehicles transporting hazardous materials in a quantity requiring placards), traveling in the State in which the vehicle is registered or another State,
