



A. The Grantee understands that the Grantor has entered into an Interagency Agreement with the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). The FHWA's DelMar Division will provide the Grantor construction grant monitoring assistance with this project, including providing FHWA Full Federal oversight of the project and advising the Grantor regarding compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act.

B. The Grantee shall ensure that its execution of the project is in compliance with the requirements specified in this Agreement or as otherwise required by FHWA's Full Federal oversight procedures, whichever is the more restrictive, provided, in the case of material conflicts between the requirements specified in this Agreement and FHWA requirements, the requirements of this Agreement prevail.

C. The Grantee shall submit payment requests based on OEA instructions and provide copies to FHWA DelMar Division.

D. The Grantee shall submit Interim and Final Reports accompanied by FHWA DelMar Division's memorandum of review, electronically to the Grantor through the EADS2 system.

E. Interim Project Development Time Schedule:

Completion of Design: November 2017
Start of Construction: February 2018
Completion of Construction: August 2020

Failure to meet the Project Development Time Schedule is considered a violation of the Grant Agreement and may result in action by the Grantor to suspend and/or terminate the Grant. The Project Development Time Schedule may only be extended as a result of a written request from the Grantee and a written approval by the Grantor.

F. Prior to disbursement of funds, the Grantee will provide to the Grantor a signed copy of the six-party "Memorandum of Agreement for the Design, Acquisition of Rights-Of-Way and Construction of MD355/Crossing-(BRAC)."

G. Prior to disbursement of funds, the Grantee will provide to the Grantor a signed copy of the "Construction Agreement" between the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority and Montgomery County.

H. Project underrun amounts shall be added to the Contingencies line item. Contingency funds are to be used to address situations resulting from unknown conditions and changes required for the fulfillment of authorized activities under this Award.

I. The Grantee understands and acknowledges that the Grantee is responsible for providing any funds required to complete this project (as described in the approved project Scope of Work) in excess of the Federal funds provided in this award. In accepting this grant, the Grantee agrees that any additional funds required to complete this project will be provided from non-Federal sources; will be committed to the Project; will be made available as needed; and will not be conditioned or encumbered in any way that would preclude their use consistent with the requirements of this grant. Should the Project not proceed or fail to be completed for any reason as required under the terms of this grant agreement, the Grantee must repay to OEA all Federal funds not yet expended. OEA is not liable for any obligations, expenditures, or commitments that involve any amount in excess of the Federal funds provided in this award.

J. The recipient will be responsible for any and all termination costs it may incur should this project fail to proceed for any reason.

K. The parties to this Grant Agreement contemplate that this project may be executed in coordination with a separate Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) project pursuant to a separate agreement between Montgomery County and SHA.
