B. Process for Submitting Advocacy Statements and Public Hearing Engagement

- Submitting Advocacy Letters/Statements: Committee discussed drafting an advocacy letter concerning the 5% designated in the cable budget to supplement cable entity (e.g. MCPS, MCCC) programs but appear to go to the general fund
 - a. Process for submitting an advocacy letter would be to submit MC Cable Commission Staff
 - b. After review, it would then be sent to the MC Council for consideration
- 2. Public Hearing Engagement: CCAC would seek guidance from MC Cable Commission before submitting public hearing request
 - a. Committee would review the county public hearing schedule to identify items that we would potential what to speak out on
 - Next recommended step would be to prepare the message we would like to convey then choose the individual(s) to speak on the CCAC behalf at the public hearing
 - c. Submit request to County Council to be heard at that specific hearing
