SUBJECT: Designation of the Montgomery County Department of Police to Receive Records of the Activities of Licensed Junk Dealers and Scrap Metal Processors

Background

1. Chapter 198 of the 2010 Laws of Maryland requires the governing body of each county to designate by resolution the primary law enforcement unit responsible to receive records concerning the activities of junk dealers and scrap metal processors operating in the county. This law is codified at Md. Code Ann. Bus. Reg. §17-1003(a).
2. The Montgomery County Department of Police is the primary law enforcement unit within Montgomery County.

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution:


The Council designates the Montgomery County Department of Police as the primary law enforcement unit in Montgomery County, Maryland, responsible to receive records concerning the activities of licensed junk dealers and scrap metal processors operating in the County as required by Md. Code Ann. Bus. Reg. §17-1003(a).
