SUMMARY: This regulation establishes a licensing fee schedule, specifies required signage to include a Statement that the use of tanning facilities by a minor is a violation of County Code and sets maximum ambient temperature inside the facility.

General knowledge Regarding the health risks associated within indoor tanning facilities has evolved Over time especially in regard to the use of tanning facilities by minors.

51A.05.01 Fee Schedule, Signs and Temperature Requirements for Tanning Facilities Fees

51A.05.01.01 Fees

Tanning Facility License \$265.00
Duplicate License \$ 10.00
Filing an annual renewal application after the license expires \$ 25.00

51A.05.01.02 Warning Sign

- a. A warning sign must be conspicuously displayed in each room where a tanning device is used.
- b. The warning signs must be at least 8 inches by 12 inches and the letters must be at least 2/8 inch in height.
- c. The warning sign must read: "Use of protective eyewear is required. Over exposure causes burns. Certain foods and medications may cause burning or skin sensitivity. Repeated exposure may cause premature aging of the skin and skin cancer. It is a violation of County Code §51A.00.01 for a person under the age of 18 to use a tanning device."

51A.05.01.03 Room Temperature

Ambient room temperature must [be maintained between 75° and 90°] not exceed 100°F.

51A.05.01.04 Effective Date

This regulation takes effect [on July 1, 2011] immediately after approval by the County Executive.
