Pursuant to Section 31-48, Montgomery County Code 2004, as amended, and COMCOR §31.48.01, et seq., the County Executive or his designee shall conduct a public hearing at 7 PM on Wednesday, January 7, 2015, in the Lobby Level Auditorium, Executive Office Building, 101 Monroe Street, Rockville, Maryland, to consider the creation of a new Residential Permit Parking Area in Silver Spring.

The Rosemary Hills Residential Permit Parking Area would be located in Silver Spring north of East West Highway and west of Downtown Silver Spring. A more detailed description of the area is available for examination in the Exhibits at the offices of the Montgomery County Department of Transportation, Division of Traffic Engineering and Operations located at 100 Edison Park Drive, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Gaithersburg, Maryland 20878.

After the aforesaid Hearing, the Hearing Examiner shall report his findings and recommendations to the County Executive who shall issue a statement of his decision.
