Summary: This regulation amends COMCOR 20.41.01 to amend the service charge for dishonored checks or drafts.

Background: The service charge has not been amended since 1992. State law authorizes a \$35.00 fee and this regulation will modify the County fee to be consistent with the fee authorized by State law and allow the fee to increase if State law changes to allow a larger fee.

COMCOR 20.41.01 Dishonored Check Fees

20.41.01.01

Section 20-41 of the Montgomery County Code 1984, imposes a service charge of ten dollars (\$10.00) or such other reasonable amount as may be established by executive regulation under method (3) of Section 2A-15 of the County Code when any check or draft tendered to the County in payment of any tax, fee, charge, penalty, interest or fine is dishonored by a bank.

20.41.01.02

A service charge in the amount of \$[2] 35.00 or such other greater amount as authorized by State law, is imposed on each dishonored check or draft tendered to the County.

20.41.01.03

The service charge is due on each dishonored check or draft unless otherwise provided in other laws, resolutions or regulations.

20.41.01.04


The Director of Finance may require that the total amount due, including the service charge, be paid in cash, certified check or money order.

20.41.01.05 Effective Date

This regulation takes effect 30 calendar days after the deadline for comments published in the Register.
