HUMAN RIGHTS HALL OF FAME
NOMINATION FORM**

On Sunday, October 28, 2012, the Montgomery County Office of Human Rights (OHR) will host its seventh biennial Human Rights Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony to honor individuals who have made great personal sacrifices in contributing to human and civil rights in Montgomery County, either as trailblazers of the past or as current light bearers in the struggle. The Human Rights Hall of Fame mission is to recognize visionary leadership, outstanding achievement, and altruism on the road to eliminating discrimination, diminishing the effects of discrimination, and advancing human rights.

Selection criteria for Hall of Fame members, living or deceased are exemplary leadership, notable achievement, and lasting impact within Montgomery County’s human rights movement. Hall of Fame inductees, nominated by the community and selected by a panel of community judges, may not include current staff members of the Montgomery County Office of Human Rights.

To nominate an individual for the Hall of Fame, submit a typed narrative, not to exceed two pages, that documents your nominee’s achievement(s), accomplishment(s), and contribution(s) to human and civil rights in Montgomery County:

The narrative must include the following information about your nominee’s human rights endeavors: * Contributions toward Eliminating/Mitigating Discrimination in Montgomery County * Lasting Community Impact * Exemplary Leadership * Outstanding Achievement * Selfless Contributions/Personal Sacrifices * Vision * Accomplishments within the Civil/Human Rights Arena
