



DRIVEWAY INSPECTIONS

After permit issuance, and 48 hours prior to starting driveway construction, the permittee must contact

the DPS ROW Inspector **listed on the permit** to schedule an inspection. The permit requires a minimum

of three inspections:

- Pre-construction
- Forms, sub grade
- Final be sure to arrange for this final inspection. Once passed, the process for the bond release will begin.

The applicant secures his/her own contractor to construct the driveway. DPS does not construct the driveway for the applicant. For the permit to be considered finalized and the bond returned, a final inspection must be made.
