

5 Things You Should Know If You

MISSED A COURT HEARING

1. Do not give up! If you received a deportation order for missing a hearing, you can ask the judge to rescind the deportation order and reopen your case.
2. You should find a lawyer that can help you submit a petition as soon as possible.
3. It is important to start NOW. The process will take time and you are more likely to reopen your case if you submit the petition before 180 days – or 6 months – of the missed hearing.
