





COVID-19 CASES PER CAPITA OVER TIME





COVID-19 VACCINATIONS—OVER 1 MILLION DOSES ADMINISTERED





RELATIVE VACCINATION RATES OVER TIME BY RACE/ETHNICITY






VACCINATION VOLUME BY GROUP: CHANGE OVER TIME


Volume has fallen across all groups. Decline in first doses among Hispanic and Black/AA residents relative to last week was less pronounced than for White and Asian residents. The 16-54 population continued to account for over 80% of vaccinations last week (not shown in charts).






COUNTY GOVERNMENT COORDINATED VACCINATIONS

Primary sites now at Mont College (Germantown) and Silver Spring Civic Center.





VACCINATIONS OF COUNTY RESIDENTS BY PROVIDER TYPE AND LOCATION




GEOGRAPHY: PERCENT VACCINATED (AT LEAST ONE DOSE)
