The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that portion of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Montgomery County, Maryland, approves the following ordinance:

Sec. 1. Chapter 50 is amended as follows: 1 2 **Division 50.4. Preliminary Plans** 3 * * 4 Section 50.4.2. Approval Procedures 5 * 6 7 Ε. Plan Certification. 1. Every preliminary plan approved by the Board must be certified 8 by the Director to confirm that the plan reflects the Board's 9 10 approval. Any modification of the plan conditioned by the Board's approval must be included in the plan before receiving 11 the approval stamp. The approved plan must be filed in the 12 records of the Board. 13 After conditional use approval and prior to certification of a 2. 14 preliminary plan, the Director may approve a minor change to a 15 preliminary plan that was approved contingent on the approval 16 of a conditional use application, if the minor change does not 17 modify a condition of the preliminary plan. The Director may 18 approve these minor changes without a public hearing if no 19 objection to the application is received within 15 days after the 20 conditional use is approved. If an objection is received within 21 15 days and the Director considers the objection relevant, a 22 public hearing and action by the Board is required. The Director 23 may also require the change be acted on by the Board when no 24

objection is received.
