- To lead the development of a Digital Business Strategy with a portfolio of opportunities to digitize manual processes
- To collaborate on strategies to improve the Internet of Things blueprint for County Government
- To enhance Montgomery County's ability to establish technology-related public-private partnerships
- To report to the CIO/Director and manage the staff function that focuses on digital transformation County-wide
- To enhance our front-facing technology brand to the public
- To meet the need of this critical role to support the County's recovery going forward; addressing the new norm
