



**Testimony of Farin Alimo,  
Montgomery College Takoma Park/Silver Spring Campus Student  
Montgomery County Council  
FY23 Capital Budget Hearing  
February 8, 2022**

Good afternoon, Council President Albornoz and members of the Montgomery County Council. My name is Farin Alimo. I am a Burtonsville resident and the vice president of the Montgomery College Takoma Park/Silver Spring Student Senate. I am studying communications, international relations, and linguistics. I hope to transfer next year to earn a bachelor's degree. I am honored to speak to you and to represent the incredible students at my college.

I grew up in Montgomery County and know how valued libraries are here—that's one of the reasons I want to continue living in this county. Just recently, I've helped new Afghani refugees in Montgomery County get acclimated to our campus, and utilize the library to work on their English skills.

I ask that you fully fund the MC FY23 capital budget and fund the TP/SS library renovation so students can access study spaces, technology, and books they need to succeed.
