I do my own yard work. As I have limited time available for this I purchased a commercial grade gas powered leaf blower some years ago. It was expensive but really does the job. At the rate I use that machine I suspect it will outlast me so no amount of phase-in time will work. I would be happy to switch to a similarly battery powered machine but should not be financially penalized for continuing to use a machine that was legally purchased. If the County decides to outlaw the use of a legally purchased machine, I would hope owners of such equipment would be granted an exception to use their equipment. Otherwise, I think the County should replace my model with an equally powered battery version.
