While you talk about affordable housing and overlook the real estate tax burden you place on Senior citizens.

With the current real estate credits, I will need be 100 before I am eligible.

I am currently applying for part time jobs with the County to become eligible for z first responder real estate tax credit.

I have no children in MCPS, and still, I have to watch the school ask for and get budget increases.

Taxation without consideration makes housing unaffordable for Montgomery County Seniors. Please consider this dilemma.
