STATEMENT REGARDING THE DISPOSITION OF GARAGE #2

Dear Council President Friedson and Council Members,

By way of introduction, I am Karla Kramer, a resident of Woodside Park in Silver Spring. I am writing to express my support for the Declaration of No Further Need for the G2 Spring Cameron Garage at 1200 Spring Street.
