Hay una tienda de licores que funciona por mas de 15 anos ,esta ubicada muy cerca a nuestro conjunto habitacional. Por las tardes y noches , personas bajo la influencia de alcohol o drogas se reunen frente al local y sus alrededores, generando ruido, discusiones y comportamientos agresivos.

Un ejemplo concreto: un nino de nuestra comunidad, al regresar de la escuela, se sintio asustado al ver las peleas y escuchar gritos frente a la licoreria. Desde entonces, sus padres deben acompañarlo todos los días porque no se sienten seguros dejandolo caminar solo.

En algunas noches han intendado abrir las puertas de nuestros carros personas alcolizadas y con otras substancias. Somos una comunidad de 50 casas nuevas que compramos en un valor muy alto y pagamos taxes altos, Este ptoblema esta afectado a todos los residentes de la comunidad , nuestros hijos deberian poder ir y regresar de la escuela de manera segura y nosotros sentirnos seguros.

La comunidad ya ha expresado su preocupacion , pero la situacion persiste.

Pedimos fondos publicos para Montgomery Village para poder tener mas patrullaje y tener mas control de horas de operacion de la licoreria, Le pedimos su apoyo para bucar soluciones que protejan a nuestros ninos y mejoren la seguridad en nuestra area y

Good afternoon Montgomery County Council,

My name is Lorena Mosquera and I am a resident of Montgomery County. Today I would like to draw your attention to a problem that affects the safety and well-being of our children and neighbors in Montgomery Village DBR Homes.

There is a liquor store that has been in operation for over 15 years. This store is located very close to our residential complex. In the afternoons and evenings, people under the influence of alcohol or drugs gather in front of the establishment and in surrounding areas, making noise, arguing and behaving aggressively.

A concrete example: a child in our community who was returning from school felt frightened when he saw fights and heard gunshots in front of the liquor store. Since then, his parents must keep him company when walking because they do not want him to walk by himself.

On several nights, individuals under the influence of alcohol and other substances have attempted to open the doors of our cars. We are a community of 50 new homes. Property we have purchased at a very high price and for which we pay high taxes. This problem is affecting all the residents of the community; our children should be able to travel to and from school safely, and we should feel safe.

The community has already expressed its concern, yet the situation persists.

We are requesting public funds for Montgomery Village to enable increased patrols and greater oversight of the liquor store's hours of operation. We ask for your support in seeking solutions that protect our children and improve safety in our area.
