The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that portion of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Montgomery County, Maryland, approves the following Ordinance:

Sec 1. Section 50-34 is amended as follows:

2 50-34. Preliminary subdivision plans-Filing and specifications.

4 (a) General. Every proposed subdivision or resubdivision shall be submitted to
5 the board for tentative or conditional approval in the form of a preliminary
6 plan prior to the submission of a subdivision record plat. The plan shall show
7 graphically all facts needed to enable the board and other public agencies to
8 determine whether the proposed layout of the land in question is satisfactory
9 from the standpoint of the public health, safety and welfare and the
10 regulations, ordinances and laws applicable.

agent shall file the preliminary subdivision plan with the board in the form of a tracing drawing, together with the application for its approval and at the same time shall deposit the appropriate fee for its processing. Fees for processing shall be established by resolution adopted by the board from time to time.

Such fees shall not be higher than reasonably necessary to cover the cost of processing and administration. The subdivider or an agent must also file with the application[[,]] a receipt from [[Montgomery]] the County showing payment of [[the]] any [[fee]] fees required [[by the Department of Public Works and Transportation]] in connection with the [[Department's]] County's review [[and participation in the subdivision review]] process.
