Comprehensive Water Supply and Sewerage Systems Plan Amendments Final Approval Action for Administrative Delegation Action AD 2019-2: WSCCR 19-TRV-06A

May 23, 2024

AUTHORITY: Chapter 1, Section III.D.10. "Conditional Category Changes", of the Montgomery County Ten-Year Comprehensive Water Supply and Sewerage Systems Plan authorizes the Director of the Montgomery County Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) to grant final approval for water/sewer service area category change requests (WSCCRs) which have previously received a conditional approval.

BACKGROUND • Conditional Approval Action: The Montgomery County DEP Director acted to conditionally approve service area category change request WSCCR 19-TRV-06A (Yujin and Yinghua Wang) under Administrative Delegation Action AD 2019-2 on April 29, 2019. Under this action, the director placed the following condition for final approval of sewer category S-3 for the request:

"Maintain S-6, with advancement to S-3 (Potomac peripheral sewer service policy) conditioned on MNCPPC approval of an administrative subdivision plan for a lot that satisfies minimum zoning and subdivision requirements. The property must be served by a sewer extension to the main located to the west on Overlea Dr., a gravity main extension to the Watts Branch Trunk Sewer, as considered by WSSC, is not allowed. Administrative policy V.D.2.a: Consistent with Existing Plans.

Fulfillment of Conditions: On August 18, 2022, a deed was recorded in the County's land records (Liber 66157, Folio 264-270) transferring a part of the existing Lot 3, Block 6, Glen Hills Section 2, back to the partial lot 4, Block 6, Glen Hills Section 2, the subject of WSCCR 19-TRV-06A. This was the same property previously deeded to Lot 3. The resulting combined property reestablishes the original Lot 4 shown on plat no. 1914. A confirmatory deed for Lot 4, returned to its original configuration, was recorded in the land records at L. 67956/F.359-362. According to MNCPPC staff in the Intake and Regulatory Coordination Division, this process will allow the restored Lot 4 to apply for a building permit without needing to have an administrative subdivision approval. The applicant has presented a proposal by WSSC Water for allow-pressure sewer extension to the west towards Circle Dr. that would serve this lot. The conditions for final approval for sewer category S-3 are resolved.

DEP FINAL APPROVAL ACTION: The water and sewer categories designated by the Montgomery County Comprehensive Water Supply and Sewerage Systems Plan are hereby amended as follows:




Water and Sewer Service Area Category Change Map (see page 4)
