Plant Closure

Dickerson Generating Station completed operations of coal units 1-3 July 30th, 2020.

- Combustion turbines (natural gas / oil) will continue to operate.
- Plant decommissioning activities:
 - Disconnect fuel sources into coal units and electrical feed coming from coal units –
 required to show MDE that units not capable of creating emissions; deactivate Title V air permit.
 - o Drain oils from operating reservoirs; move to recycle opportunities.
 - Sending unused coal off to be re-used. Will scrape coal pile area to remove coal bits mixed with dirt.
 - o Disconnecting unnecessary onsite electric demand (station service).
 - o Send unused products/materials to other GenOn Power Plants.

Westland Ash Landfill

No ash removed from Westland in last quarter. Ash buyers paused work at Westland for \sim 3 months and complete work at R. Paul Smith Plant in Williamsport, MD.

Waiting approval from MDE on Ash Removal Plans for Phases 2-5. No cap to be removed during these stages. Should supply needs of cement clients through 2021.

Negative tons indicate ash removed from Plant taken to Westland and sent for cement immediately.
