Coal Plant Decommissioning/Caretaking (Dickerson Infra-Development, LLC.)

- Safety concerns for the period None

 - Property sale to Terra Energy preparing to close
- NPDES permit remains in place.

Combustion Turbine Site (Dickerson Power, LLC.)

 - o 95 starts / 492 Service Hours thru Aug 2022
 - o 220 Starts in 2021 / 1630 Service Hours in 2021

Westland Ash Landfill (Maryland Ash Management, LLC.)

- No operational issues during the period
 - Processed and discharged 2,433,400 gal thru WWTP thru Aug 2022
 - Responded with findings to Steve Martin (DEP) regarding early morning truck noise at Westland
- Ash mining activities were steady during the period
 - 129,067 tons of Fly Ash removed in 2022
 - o 433,555 removed since project start

GenOn Dickerson Water Appropriations Difference (Prior ask from DAFIG):

- With Coal the daily max flow was 2M gallons (annual average) for cooling and another 981.5K gallons (annual average) for FGD/SNCR
- Current daily max flow is 39K gallons (annual average) for Dickerson Power
