- 3. Updates on revised ACM Submitted to MDE in April 2016
 - a. **ACM status-**DSWS submitted the revised ACM to MDE in April 2016. Prior to the submittal DSWS had a community meeting on April 18, 2016. During this meeting, DSWS made a presentation showing the revisions to the ACM report submitted in January 2014. MDE approved the revised ACM report on July 8, 2016. The Consent Order Executed by Montgomery County and MDE requires the County to schedule and hold a Public Informational Meeting to discuss the findings of the investigation and to discuss the remedial actions for the landfill. The approved ACM Report modifies the remedies selected in the January 2014 ACM Report submitted to MDE. The original January 2014 report proposed bioremediation as a remedial option; however, in the final report, MDE approved toupee (partial) capping of the site along with gas collection system improvements as the selected preferred methods to address contamination from the landfill. Montgomery County DEP will hold a public informational meeting to discuss the findings of the investigation and to discuss the remedial actions for the Gude Landfill.
 - b. Public Outreach-The proposed meeting will also address, timeframes, communication and community outreach plans going forward, mitigants, reuse (near- and long-term), the potential use of the landfill during remediation, the process and steps for determining eventual re-use, the budget process for the remediation project, especially incorporating into the budget community enhancements and mitigants. Any other issues concerning the GLCC community will be added to the agenda on October 19, 2016 Public Information meeting. This new information material could provide greater detail regarding approaches to mitigation of impacts to the community during remediation. DEP will send a copy of the meeting notice to approximately 30 commercial property owners adjacent to Landfill identified from tax maps. A copy of the notice has already sent as a flyer to GLCC. GLCC assured DEP that they would email the flyer to all residential property owners registered with them. Also, a press release is being issued by the County PIO for the entire Capital area media regarding the meeting. Hopefully, all these actions should meet the intent of the Consent Order Paragraph 9.
