
Filing your Annual Business Recycling and Waste Reduction Report Online

January 18, 2023







What is the Annual Business Recycling and Waste Reduction Report?

- Details the types and amounts of materials recycled and the amount of waste disposed during the previous calendar year as well as educational and waste reduction efforts.
- Submitted annually by certain businesses to the Montgomery County Recycling and Resource Management Division.
- Data submitted by businesses helps the County determine their recycling rates and assess recycling efforts and opportunities for assistance.





Who Needs to File

Deadlines

If your business or property is a:	Your filing deadline is:
Large business (250+ employees)	February 1
Medium business (100-249 employees)	
Small business (fewer than 100 employees) that received a written request from RRMD	March 1
Commercial property owner or manager of multi-tenant facilities	

Mandatory Recyclable Materials

Mixed paper

- White and colored paper
- Newspapers, magazines and catalogs
- Telephone directories and books
- Cardboard and boxboard
- Shredded paper

Commingled materials

- Plastic bottles and containers
- Glass bottles and jars
- Bi-metal cans, aluminum cans and foil products

Scrap metal

Yard trim and Christmas trees

Voluntary Recyclables

Businesses may report on additional recycling efforts including:

- Carpet and carpet padding
- CFL light bulbs and tubes
- Cooking oil
- Electronic items
- Food scraps for composting
- Textiles
- Toner cartridges
- Plastic wrap and bags
- Wood pallets
- And more....

What you need to know before you start...

- Types of materials your business/organization is recycling.
- Names and addresses of the collectors transporting your recyclable materials and refuse.
- Size and number of central collection containers for each recyclable material and refuse.
- Collection frequency.
- Quantity of material collected in the previous calendar year.

Where do you get this information...

- Contact your collector (*Don't wait until the last minute to call!*)
 - *You must obtain actual weights for compactors
