



LAYHILL SOUTH MICRO-SURFACING PROJECT

Silver Spring, MD

PURPOSE

This newsletter is to inform you of the upcoming micro-surfacing of the Layhill South neighborhood from Randolph Road to Camellia Drive. Please see the reverse side of this newsletter for the project map. This project will consist of the application of slurry on the existing pavement. This pavement system preservation project employs long term strategies to improve roadway conditions.



SCHEDULE

This project is scheduled to start in mid-July and will take roughly 6 days to complete, weather and other operational requirements permitting. Work hours will be between 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday.

IMPACTS

No parking signs may be posted in advance of patching on your street. You will have access to your driveway and street throughout the duration of the project. Please walk or drive carefully through the work zone and obey all posted signage. We thank you for your cooperation and patience as we work to improve the County infrastructure for residents and users.



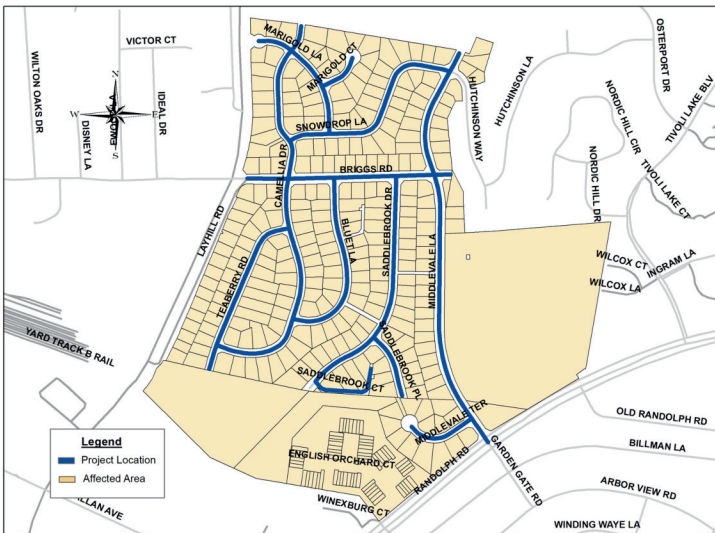
