This project will consist of full width Tar & Chip from Route 28 to Route 117 followed by Fog Seal application to elimate dust and preserve the Tar & Chip. This pavement management preservation project employs long term strategies to improve roadway conditions.

You will have access to your driveway and street throughout the duration of the project. Please walk or drive carefully through the work zone and obey all posted signage. SCHEDULE


