

Parking lots and garages can be very dangerous for both children and adults. Remember these tips to help avoid an accident:

Parents: Teach your children

- …that parked vehicles might move. Always stay alert for vehicles and don't assume the driver can see you.
- …not to exit the car by themselves, even if the doors are unlocked. If parallel parked, always exit towards the sidewalk.
- …to always hold your hand and never run in the parking lot.
- ...to always be aware of their surroundings-keep their head up and their eyes open. Stay off the phone and definitely do not text and walk.

For Kids:

- ...Never play with the door release lever inside the car it may open when it is not safe to exit.
- ...Wait for a parent or adult to open your door from the outside. Do not exit the car by yourself.
- …Stay with your parents and always hold their hand.
-Never run out of the car or chase anything through the parking lot.
- …Treat the parking lot like a street. Look both ways before crossing, use crosswalks, and always use sidewalks whenever possible.
