DESCRIPTION OF AMENDMENT

The following changes are applicable to the RFQ:

CHANGE #1

The text for Subsection 17.2 of Section A of the RFQ has been revised to read:

All maintenance will be performed using industry standard practices. The Offeror will be responsible for the maintenance of all advertising media in a professional manner on buses, shelters and bike stations. The Offeror will also be responsible for the maintenance of the internal bus shelter ad panels, ensuring that they are kept clean, clear and highly visible at all times. At no time will the Offeror schedule or perform maintenance that will impede or interfere with the operation of MCDOT services or maintenance practices. All maintenance will be performed in cooperation with the MCDOT Fleet Management Division. This requires that maintenance be scheduled at times and in locations that are acceptable to the Fleet Management Division. At all times, the employees of the Offeror will be allowed the right of reasonable entry and egress to all facilities subject to the rules and regulations of MCDOT. All the Offeror's employees will wear MCDOT Offeror Identification Cards at all times when on MCDOT property or servicing MCDOT transit items.

CHANGE #2

The date for receipt of offers has been extended from no later than March 7, 2022, at 3:00 P.M., to no later than March 14, 2022, at 3:00 P.M.

Answers and clarifications to Offerors questions resulting from the Optional Pre-submission Conference held at February 14, 2022 and received via email by the requested date have been posted online at <https://www.montgomerycountymd.gov/DOT-Transit/RFQAvailability.html>

During the Pre-Submission Conference, MCDOT stated that no maintenance is required of the Offeror. Even though this was stated during the conference with regards to overall shelter maintenance, the offeror will be responsible for the maintenance of the internal bus shelter ad panels, ensuring that it is kept clean, clear and highly visible at all times. MCDOT will be responsible for the initial provision of the shelter ad panels in a state of good repair to the offeror. The offeror will also be responsible for the maintenance of all advertising media in a professional manner on buses, shelters and bike stations
