# **Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE)**

- MDE received the second draft of the new SWM regulations.
- Regulations are touted as large storm resiliency.
- The Tech Advisory Group will meet in April 2024.

### **Old Business**

- Peer Review is moving forward but lacks participation.
- Simplifile is working well with no delays.
- DOT has not agreed to meters in the ROW.
- GIS Maps are live, including the U & O module; DPS suggests continuing to complete field verification as data comes from DOT.

### **New Business**

- Recommend revising the maximum height allowance for fence permitting when the resident owns a dog.
- Green code was sent to Sean for comment; changes include using the ASHRAE 91.1 standard.
